<b>Student VISA</b>	
Student visa to enter Argentina.	Students must obtain a study visa before coming to Argentina. The student must contact the Argentine Consulate corresponding to his area of residence in his country of origin to carry out the corresponding procedure.
Document delivered by UCES to the student.	Once the student has started the process at the Argentine Consulate, the document "Constancia de inscripcion electronica" (digital registration certificate) will be required. This document will be provided by UCES and sent to the student via email.
Important notice	Student VISA is mandatory.

<b>Health insurance</b>	
Medical and disability insurance is compulsory for taking part in UCES academic exchange program. UCES requires that all international students are covered by a health insurance that includes medical diagnosis and treatment, preventive medicine, hospitalization, surgery and transplants, dental care, first aid and transportation to a hospital or clinic, medical equipment and appliances, treatment of chronic diseases, paramedical services and repatriation of mortal remains.
