Introduction

Universidad del Salvador (USAL) is a private higher education institution - founded in 1956 by the Society of Jesus - which has a local student population of over 15,000 and welcomes about 300 exchange students per year. USAL is strongly committed to internationalization through a policy of global cooperation that leads to joint research projects, double degree programs, COILs, active participation in Erasmus projects and the implementation of a solid strategy of international student enrollments, domestic student mobility, the introduction of courses in foreign languages and visiting international scholar hosting.

USAL has over 300 institutional partners in 54 countries and has been a member of ISEP since 1986, strengthening its global presence through participation in International events such as NAFSA and EAIE on a yearly basis. With a vast academic offer, USAL offers more than 140 undergraduate and graduate programs, distributed across 10 faculties specialized in various areas of knowledge. Its academic community consists of over 3,000 professors and researchers, ensuring high-quality education based on scientific, humanistic, and Christian principles.

USAL was founded by the Society of Jesus, continuing the educational tradition that began in Argentina in the 17th century. Throughout its history, the university has evolved to adapt to the challenges of the modern world, maintaining a humanistic and scientific focus in its teaching approach and methods.

Campuses and Locations

Its Headquarters are located in Buenos Aires and consist of twelve buildings strategically distributed within walking distance in the heart of the city.
