Elizibility

To be eligible to study at UC on Exchange, applicants must:

- Have successfully completed at least
 one year of full-time study at their
 home university
- Have at least an average grade point average of 4.0 on a 7-point scale.

Enrol for full-time study at UC, i.e., 12

- credit points, or four units/subjects, per semester.
- Meet all UC entry requirements, including English language requirements outlined below.

English Language Requirements

UC standard undergraduate degree

IELTS Academic	6.0 overall with no band below 6.0
TOEFL IBT1	Overall score of 60 with: R: 13 L: 12 S: 18 W: 21
PTE Academic	50 with no skill score below 50
Cambridge English Scale	169 with no sub-score below 169
Occupational English Test	No grade lower than 'C' in any of the sub- tests

It is important that students meet the English language requirements or schedule an English language test prior to nomination. This ensures ample time to process their application, address any unforeseen issues, and allow sufficient time for obtaining visas or any other necessary documentation.

When applying to the University of Canberra, please make sure that students submit clear, translated copies of their English language proficiency and transcripts.
