Nomination process	A nomination link will be sent out to partner institutions at the beginning of the nomination period.
Nomination deadlines	Winter semester: 5 May 2025 Summer semester: 3 November 2025
Application process	After the nomination has been checked, students receive an e-mail with further information and a link for registering in our application platform (Mobility Online). Students are asked to fill in the online application, provide several application documents (deadline 26 May / 25 November) and choose their courses via Mobility Online (June / December).
