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1. General Requirements

Students should preferably be in their **3rd study year in Management or Economics** (or have gained a min. of **90 ECTS credits before the exchange for an English-conducted program or 80 ECTS credits for a French-conducted program**). If this requirement is not met, please inform Muriel Bequet who will check possible acceptance.

Min. 10 ECTS at HEC per semester + French (Optional)

2. Language Requirements (in the selected teaching languages)

Upper-intermediate level **B2** (European standards) in French and/or in English is required according to the student's program. Non-native speakers are requested to provide an equivalent international language certificate (**TOEFL (80), TOEIC (785), IELTS (6.0), FCE, ...**) or university certificate with the application form.

3. Nominations

Nominations should be sent by **email** one month before the application deadline directly to mobil.in@uliege.be and cc incoming.hec@uliege.be with the following information:

6. Courses Offer and Timetables

Except for some ERAS course codes, the courses offered in our lists are part of programs for degree-seeking students. Students should ensure that they select the courses adequately based on the information below. Students should also ensure that they are able to attend all classes (check **online schedule** in the course description).

Course division:

- **Undergraduate courses** are open to students with **max. 3 years of university education** in Business/Management or Economics
- **Undergraduate/Graduate courses** are open to students with **min. 2 years of education** in Business/Management or Economics.
- **Graduate courses** are open to students with **min. 3 years of university education** in Business/Management or Economics
- **Advanced Graduate courses** are open to **senior students with a major in specialization**. However, approval from the professor should be ensured before the selection
- **Some courses have a limited number of seats.** Acceptance will be approved by the professor.
- **For special course request, please contact HEC advisor, Muriel Bequet who will advise. Course selection will be adapted if necessary.** Schedules are available in the course description. (Personal schedule will be available after full completion of the registration process at ULiege – 2 weeks before arrival).

8. Learning Agreement

The Learning Agreement (LA) should be sent through the on-line [Application form](#). Erasmus students should send their *Before the mobility* part before arrival. **Exceptional changes** are allowed during two weeks at the beginning of each semester through the *During the mobility* form. Students are invited to use their **home university LA form**.

Learning agreement signed prior to **31 August** is to be considered purely indicative and does not constitute a guarantee of a final course program. Definitive validation of learning agreement will take place from **1 September** on.

Fall semester: No changes allowed after September 30, 2026
Spring semester: No changes allowed after February 14, 2027

9. Exams, Grading System and Transcripts

Exams are either **written** or **oral** (with business attire) or **both**. They can be substituted by ongoing assessment or group work (with presentation). Class participation can also be integrated in the final note. Exam information is available in the course description. Transcripts will be sent in **March** (Fall) or **June** (Spring) and in **September** (Retakes).

Grades range from 0/20 to 20/20. 10/20 is the lowest passing grade:
