Application Procedure	All other application documents and materials should be submitted and managed through the International Office of the home university of exchange students. 1) Nomination list completed by the exchange program coordinator of the home university; 2) Manual for Exchange students sent by GDUFS to each partner home university before the first week of April (for Fall semester exchange) and the second week of October (for Spring semester exchange of the coming year); 3) Complete on-line application through official website: http://gdufs.17gz.org/ 4) Send the on-line application number to 201810046@oamail.gdufs.edu.cn cc 200711644@oamail.gdufs.edu.cn . 5) Confirmation sent by GDUFS; 6) Letter of Admission and JW 202 form sent by GDUFS to the home university via express mail after about 45 days from the date of application confirmation; 7) Flight information sent by the home university to GDUFS; 8) Airport pickup and new student registration.
Application Details	The application should be consulted and processed between designated staff members at home and host institutions, not on an individual basis.
Visa Requirement	Foreign students seeking study in China should have a student visa (X1 or X2) which can be obtained in the nearest Chinese Embassy or Consulate. When applying for visa, students are required to submit <i>Admission Notice</i> and <i>JW202 form</i> which will be officially issued by Guangdong University of Foreign Studies

Courses and Language Requirement for Exchange Students	<p><u>1. GDUFS provides the following modes of courses selection for exchange students:</u></p> <p>A. Study Chinese language courses mainly (Exchange students have to stay in the same class for the whole semester)+ no more than 3 optional undergraduate Chinese major courses</p> <p>B. Study Chinese language courses mainly (Exchange students have to stay in the same class for the whole semester))+ no more than 3 English-taught undergraduate International Business courses</p> <p>C. Study English-taught undergraduate International Business courses mainly+ no more than 3 optional Chinese language courses</p> <p>D. Study undergraduate Chinese major courses (Exchange students have to stay in the same class for the whole semester) + no more than 3 optional English-taught undergraduate International Business courses</p> <p><u>2. Language Requirements:</u></p> <p>(1) To study International Business courses requires IELTS 5.5 or above or TOEFL 70 or above. For students who do not obtain the related English certificates, they must attend the Skype interviews to confirm their eligibility of selecting the International Business courses.</p> <p>(2) To study undergraduate Chinese major courses requires HSK 5 with scores of 180 or above.</p>
