Nominations	Exchange Coordinators nominate students by completing and returning the nomination form (as attached) via email to incoming@sufe.edu.cn before the deadlines. Upon receipt of the nominations a further automatic email will be sent to exchange partners to further provide with a link to access our online nomination portal. Once all required nomination details are completed on our portal, students will receive further instructions by email from the application portal regarding the application steps afterwards, including uploading supporting documentation.

Applications	Nominees receive an automatic email notification each to be provided with the access to online application portal, where they complete an online application and submit supplementary documentation where necessary on the application portal: 1. Applicant's details (where applicable on the portal) ; 2. Uploading supplementary documentation including but not limited to: Passport photo page, transcript, language verification proof (e.g. IELTS/TOEFL iBT/ home school's recommendation attesting language skills.)

Academic Requirements	No specific GPA / levels of academic achievements to be met. Academic backgrounds in at least one of the areas across Economics/ Management / Information Science / Engineering / Laws.
Language Requirements	For Candidates whose first language is not English or Chinese, an additional letter of approval from the home institution attesting sufficient skills qualified for undertaking exchange is required for completing their applications, alternatively, an IELTS score of at least 6.0 (or TOEFL 80 equivalent) or HSK Level 3 shall also qualify for admission.
