Considerations for Nomination & Application	The home institution's exchange coordinator should send the entire nominated student's information to <u>inbound@whu.edu.cn</u> before the deadline. In view of cultural exchange and mutual learning, applicants should, in principle, be foreign students without Chinese nationality.
	Students complete online application and upload application documents before the deadline at <u>http://fses-admin.whu.edu.cn/member/login.do</u> or <u>http://fses-admin.whu.edu.cn/</u>
	It should be noted that <b>Chinese nationality</b> students <b>cannot</b> apply for this system, and students who have registered before do not need to register again.
	After that, you will get a PDF document from this website and then send it to your home institution's exchange coordinator. The home institution's exchange coordinator will e-mail your signed application material to us (admissions@whu.edu.cn) before the deadline.
	Please pay attention that all nominated student's signed application materials should be sent together by our exchange partners abroad to <u>admissions@whu.edu.cn</u> .

Transportation& Registration	<ul> <li>We do not provide pick-up service, but you can follow the map which will be delivered to you together with the admission letter. For your convenience, we recommend that you take the taxi to arrive at school in the Luojia Gate (珞珈门). After your admission letter (录取通知书) showed to the security personnel, the taxi can enter the campus.</li> <li>You will be required to register and pay the application and accommodation fees in the School of International Education Wuhan University (武汉大学国际教育学院). The Chinese above can be provided to the taxi driver in order that you get to the right place.</li> <li>The issues after exchange students' arrival should be in the charge of the School of International Education.</li> <li>Please note: Students must enroll on time. If you cannot arrive on time due to any special reason, please apply for deferred registration (within 7 days) with the signature of your home institution's coordinator at the admissions office in the School of International Education. We do NOT accept deferred registration beyond 7 days.</li> </ul>
Orientation	Orientation will be held for all new international students within one month after the semester begins. Orientation activities are designed to help newcomers adapt to new campus life, offering useful tips and advice on all aspects of student life (choosing courses, etc.).

Health insurance	<b>Please note:</b> All the students are required to pay for the local health insurance according to the regulation of our country. 400 RMB per semester, 800RMB per year.
	Two days before your entry, please purchase insurance according to the instructions in the "Online Payment Process of Insurance for International Students in China". If you need to seek medical treatment due to covid- 19or other diseases during the quarantine period (when you arrive in China but not on campus), you are supposed to contact the insurance company to pay for the treatment expenses in accordance with the regulations of the medical insurance for international students studying in China.
