Application deadlines

15 May - winter (1st) semester / academic year (starting in October)

15 November - summer (2nd) semester (starting in February)

Application procedure

ERASMUS+ students: Nominations are to be made through an online form available on the [website of the University of Zagreb](#), at least 10 days prior to the application deadlines.

Applications are made through the **University of Zagreb central IRO office**. **Application form** and other supporting documents are available on [HOW TO APPLY](#) web page.

Students coming within FEB's bilateral agreements:

Nominations: nomination e-mails are to be sent to incoming-mobility@net.efzg.hr at least 10 days prior to the application deadlines.

Applications: students are required to send their application documents to incoming-mobility@net.efzg.hr.

Transcript of Records

Upon successful completion of selected courses, the transcripts of records will be sent usually at the **beginning of March for winter semester students** and at the **beginning of July for summer semester students**.

Transcripts **cannot be sent** until students have all their grades in the system and return all the books to the library and the student ID card to the International Office.

Accommodation for exchange students

Students coming within Erasmus+ and University of Zagreb bilateral agreements can fill out a housing request form (part of the general application form, available at the University of Zagreb IRO web page) and can apply for accommodation in student residence halls. Visa/Temporary stay permit

Visa is required for NON-EU/EEA citizens coming from a country that has a visa-regime with Croatia. The list of countries whose nationals need a visa to enter Croatia can be found on the website of the Croatian [Ministry of Foreign and European Affairs.](#)

Exchange students staying in Croatia for a period longer than three months (90 days) need to apply for the approval of the temporary stay for the purpose of studies.
