Transcripts of records	<p>Upon successful completion of all enrolled courses, transcripts of records will be sent usually at the beginning of March for winter semester students and at the beginning of July for summer semester students.</p> <p>Transcripts cannot be sent before the students have all grades in their Index, return all books to the library and student ID card to the International Office.</p>

Visa / Temporary stay permit	<p>Exchange students staying in Croatia for a period longer than three months (90 days) need to regulate the residence permit.
