- Adopting strategy "learning by doing" since 2022






LOCATION



Bachelor Study Programme - Economics and Management

- Length of study: three years

- Length of study: two years
- It prepares highly skilled professionals for mid-level and top-level management positions in:
 - Industry







SPECIALIZED COURSES - EUROTEQ








INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

- for for Spring Semester:
 - September 30 students from partner universities outside the Erasmus+ programme, and all students with non-EU citizenship coming within the Erasmus+ programme
 - **November 15** students from **partner universities within the Erasmus**+ programme and Switzerland

CTU DORMITORIES

- Erasmus and Exchange students can make a request for accommodation in a CTU dormitory here: https://web.suz.cvut.cz/Login The username and password will be sent directly to them together with the letter of acceptance
- The university offers accommodation only in shared rooms, typically in twobed rooms
- The accommodation is inexpensive, conveniently located and has excellent internet access, but it is not luxurious
- Prior to their arrival at CTU, each student must pay a security deposit via the ISKAM4 accommodation system






APPROXIMATE LIVING COSTS / PER YEAR




Food € 2 000–3 000

CULTURE AND USEFUL TIPS

People

- Most of the Czech university students have an excellent or very good knowledge of English, but some are quite shy and feel awkward speaking it
- You will find that this is a common trait in all Czech people. Don't give up, talk slowly and clearly, smile, and you will see their shyness melting and their warm heart and sense of humour appearing.
- Remember that Czech people do not appreciate superficial small talk relationships, they first have to trust you as a person before they start a real dialog.
- Czechs like to go out for a beer, have BBQ, play football or walk out their dogs






CULTURE AND USEFUL TIPS

Food

- Lunch- meal of the day--> most local restaurants therefore offer special lunch menus (11.30-15.00)- extensive (soup, main dish, desert, drink) and afordable. Ask for a daily menu (denní nabídka) instead of the regular
- □ Tips- locals tend to round their bill. A tip usully makes 10 % of the bill, but leave one only if you are happy with the service
- Try some craft beer (Matuška, Břevnovský pivovar, Chotěboř or Únětice)
- Have to try "CHLEBÍČEK" and "VĚTRNÍK"
- Ask locals what food and drink they enjoy

Public transport

- Prague has one of the most comprehensive transportation networks in the world
- Metro and regular trams stop running between midnight and around
 5 am and are replaced by night trams during this time


Activities and free time
