Tuition	\$11,025 (15 credits)	\$2,205 (3 credits)	\$4,410 (6 credits)	AUC's tuition for non-degree international students is based on a flat rate of \$735 per credit hour. Dual nationals may be eligible to pay the Egyptian tuition rate found here . Full-time semester enrollment for an undergraduate student is 12-15 credit hours and for a graduate student is 9 credit hours. Students can take a maximum of 3 credits during the winter session and 6 credits during the regular summer session. Note: Graduate-level participants in the semester-long intensive Arabic program earn 12 credit hours. All participants in the summer intensive Arabic program earn 6 credit hours.

AUC Bus Pass	\$372	\$93	\$186	Average cost of a bus subscription (rates depend on the bus route). Most study abroad students alternatively pay per bus ride or use ride-sharing services like Uber.
Survival Arabic Course	\$280	N/A	N/A	5-day intensive 20-hour course in Egyptian Colloquial Arabic that begins during orientation.

Books	\$600	\$150	\$300	AUC utilizes American textbooks for many of its courses, which should compare to US costs.
Airfare	\$1,700	\$1,700	\$1,700	Round-trip economy class ticket on a direct flight from New York City to Cairo via Egyptair (subject to change).
Visas	\$125	\$25	\$25	30-day tourist visa required to enter Egypt (\$25) and processing fee for Egyptian residency permit (~\$100).
Food	\$2,000	\$500	\$1,000	There is no meal plan at AUC but on campus there is a cafeteria, food court, coffee shops, and a convenience store. Students report spending between \$50-75 per week on food.
Personal Expenses	\$2,200	\$550	\$1,100	This cost will be determined by the individual student but may include domestic travel, money for local shopping, and a local SIM card/phone plan.
Off-Campus Housing (Optional)	\$2,500	\$625	\$1,250	Standard apartment in an off-campus residence. Semester intensive Arabic students often choose this option because their classes take place on AUC's downtown Cairo campus.
