STUDYING IN ENGLISH AT LAPLAND UAS

Lapland UAS offers a wide variety of courses taught in English. Please see the current course offer from:

Exchange students can choose courses from one study field only and from the common studies given for each semester.

Recommended study load per semester is 30 ECTS unless otherwise agreed with the sending institution and students coming for a traineeship have to complete minimum of 10 ECTS.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

The recommended language level for students is B1 based on the Common European Framework of Reference for Language (CERF). Sending institution is responsible for the evaluation of student's language competence. The level of competence is marked in the learning agreement.

LEARNING AGREEMENT

Students who apply for exchange have to prepare a study plan/ Learning Agreement (LA) for their exchange period. The study plan has to be based on the studies offered by Lapland UAS.

ACCOMMODATION ROVANIEMI

ACCOMMODATION KEMI/TORNIO

Lapland UAS co-operates with the local private sector to be able to provide accommodation for exchange students. Apartments are usually 2-3 furnished rooms, shared kitchen and a bathroom.

ORIENTATION FOR EXCHANGE STUDENTS

Each semester starts with an Orientation days for new exchange students.

Orientation is mandatory for all exchange students.

WELCOMING BUDDY

Lapland UAS assigns a welcoming buddy for all arriving exchange students. One buddy hosts a group of exchange students.

CREDITS

1 credit = 1 ECTS

Studies 30 cr. per semester / 60 cr. per academic year

GRADING

Grading of a course follows two basic practices:

- 1) Pass or Fail
- 2) Applying the following grading scale:

5 = excellent: outstanding performance with only minor errors
4 = very good: above the average standard but with some errors
3 = good: generally sound work with a number of notable errors
2 = satisfactory: fair but with significant shortcomings

1 = sufficient: performance meets the minimum criteria
0 = failed

TRANSCRIPT OF RECORDS

Students must download their transcript of records from the study system used at the Lapland UAS at the end of their exchange semester. If all course gradings are not ready by then, they can order transcript from the international services: incoming@lapinamk.fi.
