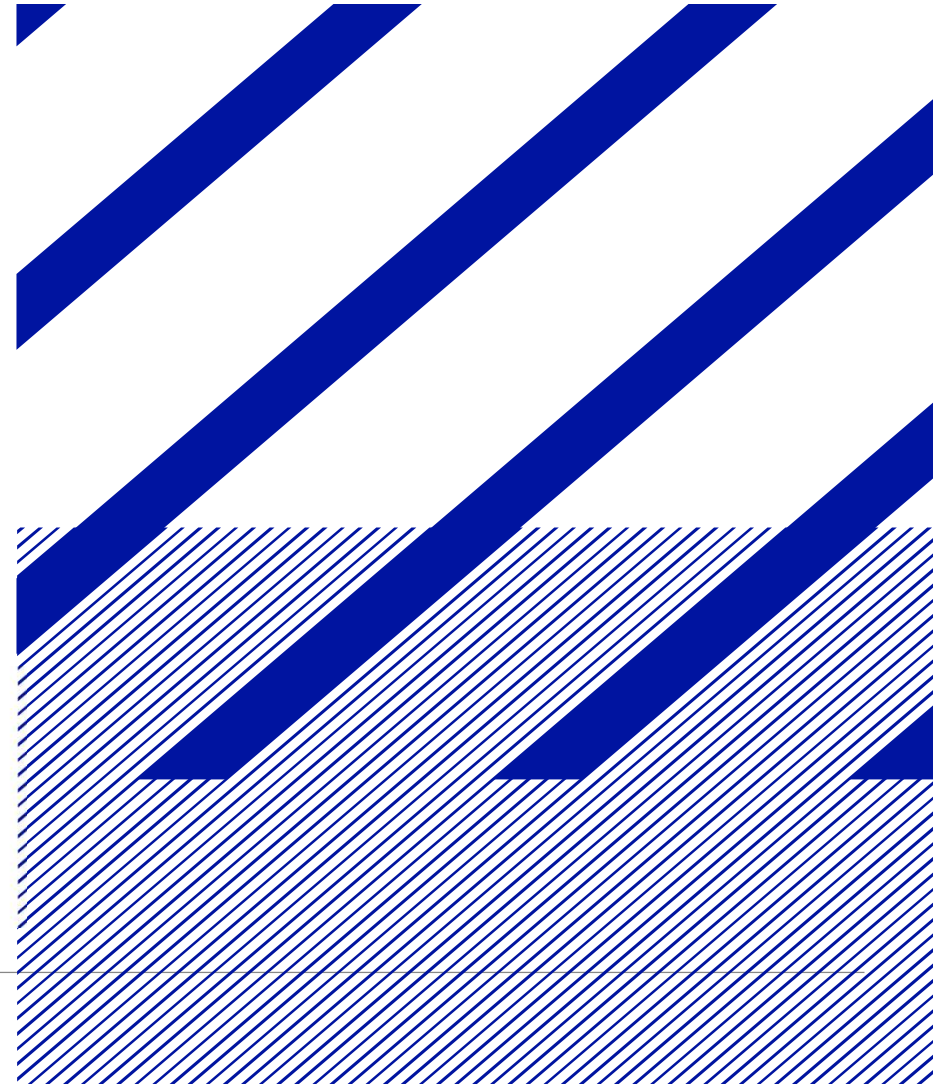

# Studying in Germany

- High quality education
- Successful economy with many international companies and subsidiaries of foreign companies
- Need of qualified professionals
- No need to speak German
- Free travel with student ticket in NRW
- Cultural life: many low budget offers for students
- sustainable and climate-friendly living conditions



Around 360,000 international students study in Germany – 12.8% of all students. Germany is the 4th most popular destination among international students after the USA, Great Britain and Australia.

# Studying in Germany

## Accommodation and cost of living

- Average spendings of a German student:  
about 860 € / month (incl. rent, groceries, sports, leisure, activities, medical bills etc.)
- Accommodation:
  - Student dorms (affordable, usually furnished)
  - Shared apartments
  - Monthly rent  $\approx$  250 - 550 €
- EU-citizens can work as much as they want as a student

1 entry ticket for a museum (reduced)	2-8 Euro

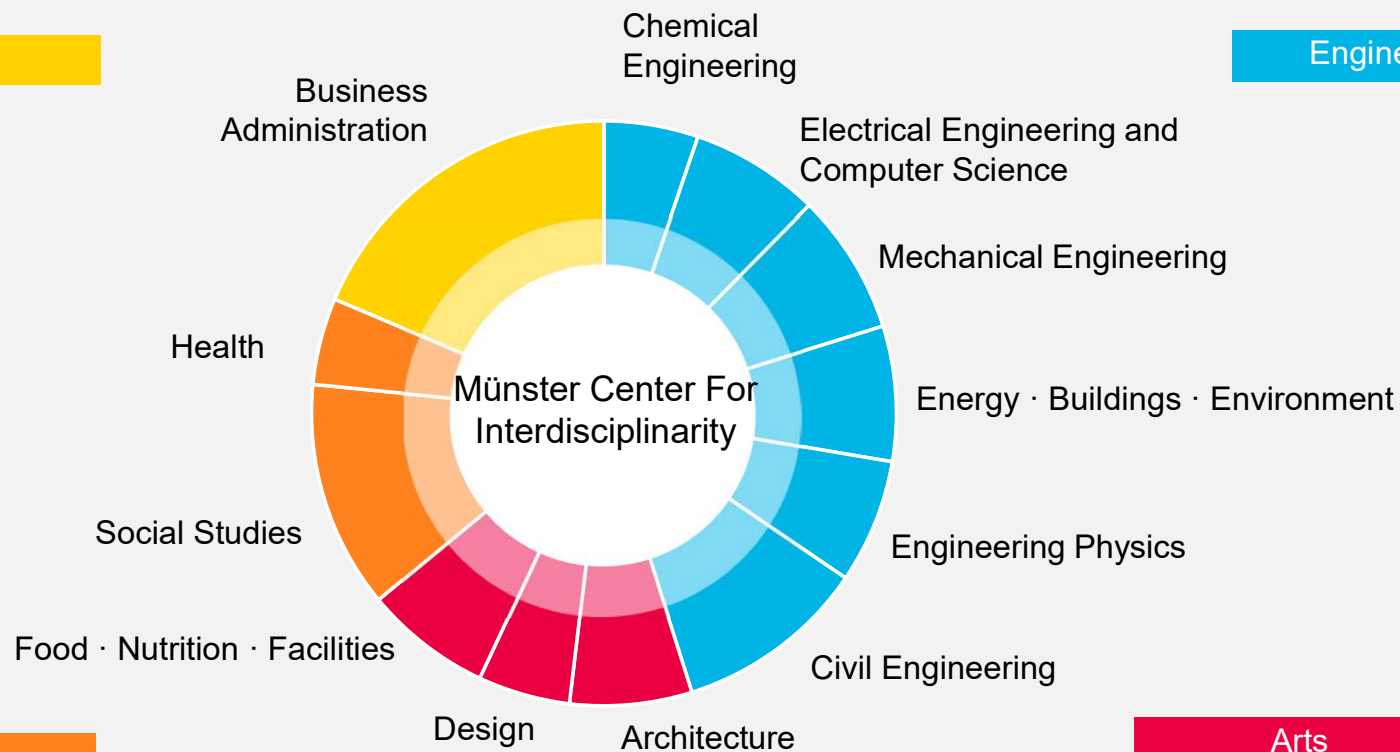

# Studying EBP double degree

## Requirements for students from Rennes School of Business

Overall you will need to have successfully completed the workload of 6 semesters = 180 ECTS credit points (CP) in the European system where each semester requires a workload of 30 ECTS-CP:

- You will bring 120 ECTS from your home institution
- You will have a language proficiency of B2 in English or German
- Minimum 60 ECTS-CP achieved at Münster School of Business (MSB) in modules
- Thesis written at MSB

(Semester of placement can differ according to agreement with your home university)

# Procedure for application & enrolment

## Application:

- Nomination of the students by home university
- Submission of documents to FH Münster
- Document + eligibility check by faculty coordinator
- Official acceptance conveyed by FH Münster

## Enrolment:

- After the official acceptance: enrolment
- Documents needed: scan of passport, health insurance
- Students have to pay a social contribution of approx. 300 € / half study year (no tuition fees!). In return, they get a semester ticket for free transport in NRW and many other concessions for 6 months
