Lingnan University Student Exchange Programme in Fall 2021 [Nomination and Application Deadline: 30 April 2021]

Eligibility:

- Full-time students of our partners and have completed at least 2 terms of full-time study partner institution
- A cumulative Grade Point Average of 2.5 (on a 4-point scale) or above
- For non-English native speaker, a TOEFL score of 213 (computer-based), 550 (paper-based) or 79 (internet-based), or an IELTS (Academic Module) score of 6.0 is required. We also accept a TOEIC score of 750* or a TOEFL ITP score of 550*.
- *additional supporting letter on the student's English language proficiency i.e. the student is able to follow classes conducted in English from partner institutions is required.
- A recommendation letter by home institution (in English, from faculty or the International Office) with comments on why the student is recommended.

Courses on Offer:

Exchange students are welcome to take any undergraduate courses from the course offering list but some courses have pre-requisite requirements/ major restrictions. Prospective students are strongly advised to seek advice from their academic advisers at home institution.


