Semester	Fall Semester – Early September to late December (including exam) Spring Semester – Jan to late May (including exam)
Application Method	HSUHK will only accept exchange students nominated by partner institutions. Applicants are required to complete a HSUHK Admission Form and submit relevant documents to HSUHK for review via partner institutions.
Nomination & Application Deadline	Fall Semester – Early to mid-April Spring Semester – Mid-October to late October
Language Requirements	Applicants are required to complete at least one term of study in home institution and attain a minimum cumulative Grade Point Average of 2.5 (on a 4-point scale) or equivalent.  For those who are not native English speakers, they are required to possess one of the following qualifications: ■ a minimum score of 550 (paper-based)/213 (computer-based)/79 (internet-based) or above in TOEFL; or ■ a minimum score of 6 or above in IELTS Proof of language capacity may be satisfied if the student has completed substantial university-level course work in English.
Useful Information	
Course Registration	Inbound exchange students are required to complete 12 credit-units (or 4 courses) min. to 18 credit-units (or 6 courses) max. No specific course restrictions applies but students are advised to check prerequisite(s) of individual courses. Exchange students can select courses from different programmes as long as the timetable allows.  HSUHK would provide students the course list in July for Fall Semester and in December for Spring Semester. <b>Accommodation</b>	Places in Residential College on campus are reserved for inbound exchange students who will be invited to submit applications in June for Fall Semester and November for Spring Semester.
<b>Estimated Living Cost</b>	Accommodation: ranges from HK\$1,900 to HK\$2,300 per month, depending on the choice of the room. Meals: around HK\$4,000 per month Personal Expenses: around HK\$2,000 per month Actual expenses depend on your personal spending habit
<b>Health Insurance</b>	Exchange students are required to purchase insurance and submit proof of insurance coverage prior to arrival. The insurance must cover travel, personal accidents, medical expenses (accident and non-accident), hospitalization and emergency evacuation/repatriation.
<b>Buddy Programme</b>	A Buddy will be assigned to each inbound student and pick-up upon arrival will be arranged by the respective Buddy.
<b>Orientation</b>	All inbound exchange students are required to attend an Orientation which usually takes place a week prior to the commencement of the semester.
