Visa and residence permit information	Students from visa-required countries may enter Hungary with a valid residence permit from their home institution country (EU). Upon arrival, they must register in Hungary as EU students. If their EU residence permit expires during their study period at IBS, they may stay in Hungary only until the permit's expiry date. If they wish to stay longer, they must apply for a Hungarian visa at the Hungarian embassy in their home institution country.
