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

ACADEMIC INFORMATION

Academic Areas

IIMU conducts an MBA program in General Management with a focus on the following areas:

- Business Policy & Strategy
- Economics
- Finance & Accounting
- Marketing
- Operations & Information Systems
- Organizational Behavior & Human Resource Management

Pedagogy

IIMU's learning methodology is imparted through case studies, discussions, management simulation, student projects, take-home assignments, and lectures.

Minimum and Maximum Course Load

The course load of incoming exchange students at IIMU depends on the number of course credits requirement by their home institute.

A four-credit course requires about 100 hours of work, including 20 class sessions of 90-minute duration. Courses of two and four credits are offered at IIMU. In special circumstances, non-credit courses with workload implications may also be offered.

Language

Proficiency in the English language is compulsory. We accept a TOEFL iBT score of 79; an IELTS score of 6.5 or a letter from the home institute confirming that the medium of instruction is English.

Attendance

A minimum attendance of 80 per cent of scheduled sessions is required in each course. However, the instructor can specify a higher minimum level of attendance as an academic requirement for the completion of a course. If a student fails to meet this requirement, due to leave without permission from the Programs Office, the instructor may award an "I" (Incomplete) grade to the student or one full grade point lower than that secured by the student in that course.

Grading

Grades are based on a five-point scale as follows:

If a student has not satisfied the academic requirements of a course, he/she may be assigned an "I" (Incomplete) grade temporarily, representing non-completion of the academic requirements for the course.

Transcript of Records

The hard copy of the transcript will be sent to the home institute after the term ends

Admission process

IIMU will invite the partner institutes to register the nominated students online. After receiving the nominations, an application link will be e-mailed to the student and the exchange coordinator of the home institute. The nominated student will have to fill in the information and upload documents such as a CV, passport, transcript and approval of his/her coordinator. Once all the information is received, IIMU will issue a letter of acceptance to students. At a later stage, students may be asked to upload more documents to facilitate their stay on campus.

Course Registration

IIMU will share a course list along with the course outlines about one month before the beginning of each term. The incoming exchange students are required to pre-register for courses according to the home institute's requirements. Students are not permitted to register for fresh courses on their arrival at IIMU or drop out of the courses that they have confirmed. This applies to all students of Terms V and VI.

Legal Formalities

On arrival, incoming exchange students need to register with the Foreign Regional Registration Office (FRRO). A set of documents like a copy of the passport, copy of the visa, passport-size photographs, etc. will be required to complete these formalities. The institute will assist the students with the process. The students are required to strictly adhere to the rules of the government and the institute throughout their participation in the STEP program.

Students are advised to complete the exit formalities with FRRO before leaving the IIMU campus.

Orientation

Incoming exchange students are welcome to contact IIMU for any information and queries before their departure. On arrival, a session will be held with the students to share information relevant to their academic and non-academic life on campus.

Visa and Insurance

Incoming exchange students are required to obtain a student visa to study at IIMU during the exchange term. Students with other types of visas are ineligible to participate in the exchange program. Students should possess a Travel & Health Insurance Policy before coming to IIMU.

Arrival

Incoming exchange students are advised to reach the IIMU campus at least two working days before the beginning of the term (early access to hostel accommodation can be requested). This will help in completing the registration formalities and familiarizing with the new surroundings before the classes begin.

Payment


The students are required to make payment for the food and accommodation charges to the Institute's bank account upon their arrival.




Student Life


