## About International Management Institute (IMI) New Delhi:

IMI New Delhi is India's first corporate sponsored Business School founded in 1981 with the original campus in New Delhi. The corporate sponsors included RPSG Enterprises (lead sponsor), ITC, Nestle, Tata Chemicals, British Oxygen, SAIL, and Williamson Magor. It was set up in collaboration with the then IMI Geneva, now IMD Lausanne. Subsequently two other campuses were set up in Kolkata (2010) and Bhubaneswar (2011).

In the last several years, IMI New Delhi has been consistently ranked in the top 10-15 Business Schools in the country and among the top 5 private Business Schools. It is accredited by the UK based Association of MBAs (AMBA) and AACSB. Both these accreditations are among the top three international accreditation bodies for Business Schools globally. It is also approved by AICTE and AIU which are the governing bodies in India.

IMI New Delhi has global linkages with leading schools in Europe, North America, and Asia. In addition, it has built a vibrant Executive Education vertical offering training to management professionals from the corporate world. The Institute provides management training to foreign nationals from developing countries under the Indian Technical & Economic Cooperation (ITEC) program of the Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India. IMI New Delhi puts a strong focus on high quality research by its faculty leading to publications in international peer reviewed academic journals. Its faculty have PhDs from top international and national universities/institutes, with many of them also having significant corporate experience

# **Academic Programmes:**

- **PGDM:** The two year Post Graduate Diploma in Management (PGDM) is the flagship program of IMI New Delhi. It is designed to prepare students for careers in industry, across functional areas. The program equips students with strong conceptual skills to manage businesses in an integrated manner. The program develops versatile managers who are capable of handling responsibilities in different business domains. The emphasis is on developing a holistic manager with a vision to take on the challenges of the future in a socially sensitive manner.
- **PGDM(B&FS):** The two year Post Graduate Diploma in Management (Banking & Financial Services) is designed to cater to the growing needs of management professionals for Banking and Financial Services industry. The program is aimed to develop high quality management professionals equipped with technical and managerial competency with a global mind set. The focus of the program is to develop a holistic and integrative approach towards management in Banking and Financial Services industry.
- PGDHRM: People are key differentiators in enabling organizations gain and maintain a competitive edge. Human Resource (HR) professionals who bring an insight for perceptive people management are increasingly in demand. Skilled HR professionals are required to address present and emerging challenges of managing the diverse needs of a growing human talent pool. The Post-Graduate Diploma in Human Resource Management PGDM (HRM) prepares a cadre of HR professionals equipped with appropriate values, perspective, and competencies to become catalysts of progressive change in the dynamic environment today.
- Executive PGDM: It is the first-of-its-breed 15 months full time general management program that has been on offer from IMI since 1984 initially under the name of Post Graduate Program in International Management. The program is custom-designed for those professionals and middle level managers who would like to rapidly transit to leadership roles. Equally, it is a tailor-made program for grooming working executives who are identified to be 'high performers' by their respective organisation.

• **FPM:** The Fellow Program in Management is the doctoral program of the International Management Institute (IMI) New Delhi. The program mix involves critical core courses, in-depth and research-based courses related to the domain interest of the candidate, individually pursued self-study courses and at the core lies the topic-of-individual-interest, that ultimately leads to the candidate's thesis. The FPM scholars are expected to work closely in their areas of interest with the faculty members of IMI to further the existing repository of both theory and practice in the field of business management. The program accepts both full-time students and part-time students.

- The summer season in India begins from March and ends in June.
- o The monsoon season starts in July and ends in September.
- The winter season starts in December and ends in February.

- The easiest way to travel around Delhi is by metro train. It connects whole of the Delhi/ NCR. It is one of the cheap options to travel in the city.
- The other way to travel is around Delhi is by three-wheeler cabs commonly known as Auto Rickshaws (autos).
- You can also catch the intercity train from New Delhi or Old Delhi Railway Station to visit and explore other parts of India.
- You can also use the radio cab services like Ola and Uber. They can be booked anytime by installing app on a smartphone.

## How to Reach IMI:


The IMI campus is well-connected, and one can reach with any available mode of transportation.

**Air:** Indira Gandhi International Airport, Delhi - 15 Km or 25 minutes' drive.

Railways: Nearest railway station is New Delhi Railway station, Delhi – 15 Km or 40 minutes. The nearest Delhi Metro Railway station is RK Puram at around 2 Km from the college.
