| Work Load / Credit Requirement | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> All incoming exchange students are expected to complete between 5 to 6 credits if they come in term: IV or V and 3 to 5 Credits if they come in term VI. However, exchange students are free to take the courses as per their University/ Institute Requirements. One credit is equivalent to 10 class-room contact hours. All core courses are typically of 2 credits and electives may be of 3, 2 and 1.5 credits. |

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| <p>Getting Here (General Information)</p> | <p>Biju Patnaik international Airport, Bhubaneswar is international as well as domestic airport. It has connectivity to all major cities in India.</p> <p>Bhubaneswar is State Capital of Odisha and is well connected with Rail and Road Network.</p> <p>Reaching IMI-B:</p> <p>From Airport: The distance of IMI Bhubaneswar is 13-14 KMs from Biju Patnaik Airport via Sum hospital. Facility of OLA, UBER and Govt. Prepaid Taxi Service is available from airport. Approximate fare from airport to Campus will be Rs. 200-250 /-. Travel Time will be around 30-40 mins.</p> <p>From Railway Station: The distance of IMI- Bhubaneswar is 15-16 Kms from Bhubaneswar Railway station via Sum Hospital. Prepaid and postpaid Auto service is available from Railway station. (Railway station area is known as Master Canteen). OLA, UBER are also available from railway station. Approx. fare for the auto and taxi is Rs. 200-250/-. Travel time will be 35-45 mins.</p> <p>From Bus stand: The distance of IMI-B is 10-11 kms from Baramunda Bus stand, Bhubaneswar via Sum hospital. OLA, UBER, Taxi and Auto-Rickshaw service is available for Gothapatna. The Course registration will be held at the Academic block, thereon they will be governed by IMI Rules. • All exchange students need to intimate their return travel plan to the student exchange officer well in advance. In case of emergency wherein a student needs to leave before completing the term the communication from the partner institute will be required for relieving the student. |
