<b>Language requirement</b>	Good command over English. No official test is required for students of partner institutions.
<b>Course enrolment</b>	A student is considered to be enrolled for a course when they complete the registration process, which takes place on the 1 <sup>st</sup> day of every trimester.
<b>Credits</b>	The normal workload is 18 credits in Trimester IV, 15 credits in Trimester V, and 18 in Trimester VI. A 3-credit classroom based course comprises of 20 classroom sessions of ninety minutes each. This amounts to 30 hours of instructor assisted learning. A 1.5-credit course comprises of 10 classroom sessions amounting to 15 hours of instructor assisted learning.
<b>Attendance</b>	<p>IMT Hyderabad insists on regular and prompt attendance in classes. The minimum required attendance for every course is 75% of the total scheduled sessions.</p> <p>Students who do not meet this criterion will not be permitted to write the end term examinations, which mean that they will not be able to complete the course.</p> <p>Attendance will be tracked for each student for each course by means of a biometric system. It is the responsibility of each student to keep track of his / her attendance.</p>
<b>Exams</b>	Exchange students are required to stay until the end of the scheduled exams as mentioned in the academic calendar.
<b>Grading</b>	<p>A student is awarded a letter grade for every course at the end of every trimester. The grades are: A (Excellent), B (Good), C (Average), D (Fair) and E (Inadequate). A student is deemed to have completed a course only if they obtain a valid letter grade.</p> <p>All letter grades have a Gradepoint, i.e., a numerical value associated with them in a quantified hierarchy. The gradepoints are as follows: A (10), B (8), C (6), D (4) and E (2).</p> <p>The GPA (Grade Point Average) is the weighted average of the gradepoints of the letter grades received by a student in all the courses taken. The GPA is calculated on a 10 point scale and is calculated using the following formula:</p> $\text{GPA} = \frac{\sum C_i G_i}{\sum C_i}$ <p>Where <math>C_i</math> is credits for course 'i' and '<math>G_i</math>' is the grade point obtained by the student in course 'i'.</p>

<b>Accommodation</b>	The institute will provide compulsory residential facilities on its premises. There are separate hostels for men and women. Students are not required to look for off-campus accommodation.
<b>Approximate expenses (per semester)</b>	<p>There are no tuition fees. Students can choose to stay for one or more trimesters, and up to an entire academic year.</p> <p>A compulsory fee of INR 30,000, towards accommodation and meal plan, is payable per trimester. This fee must be paid by online transfer, within 15 days of arrival on campus.</p>
<b>Meal plan</b>	There is a dining hall within the campus which provides four meals a day. The campus also has a cafeteria, open from 10.00am to 11.00pm, where snacks and beverages are available.
<b>Medical facilities</b>	A visiting doctor is available from 7.00 to 8.30 am and from 5.00 to 6.30 pm Monday through Friday, and from 8.00 to 9.30 am on Saturdays and Sundays. The doctor provides the prescription, however medicines and medical tests have to be taken care of by students.
<b>Visa requirements</b>	It is mandatory for all exchange students to come to IMT Hyderabad on a student visa. IMT Hyderabad will send a letter of admission as soon as the nominations are received from the respective institute and it will be the responsibility of the incoming exchange students to comply with all regulatory requirements.
