Once exchange student selects the course the request will be sent to respective department and further process will be notified. All or most classes are conducted in English, therefore students are expected to have a sufficient command of the English language to be capable of understanding, making oral presentations, writing reports and exams.	
Credit system	All the courses offered are of 3 credits each and 1 credit includes approximately 12 class contact hours.
