Insurance	 Travel Insurance- Students must make sure that they have taken Travel Insurance including emergency evacuation, repatriation incase of serious health problems etc. before they leave their home country. Health Insurance- It is strongly recommended that insurance is taken out before travelling to India. Insurance shall cover the entire duration of the Visa and travel
Visa	Must obtain Student Visa from the nearest Indian Embassy. After arrival, student must ensure that registration is done at Foreigners Regional Registration Office (FRRO) if visa is stamped with requirement for registration
