Note:

*Under MAKAUT(Maulana Abul Kalam Azad University of Technology) Assessment Marking 70%-61% is the class limit specified. But according to Rennes School of Management the limit is set to 65-69%. So, a student who scores between 61-64% will be marked 3 and will be marked 4 when the marks fall between the limit 65-69%.

**Under MAKAUT Assessment Marking 60%- 51% is the class limit specified. But according to Rennes School of Management the limit is set to 58-64%. So, a student who scores 58-63% will be marked 3 and will be marked 2 when the marks fall between the limit 50-57%.
