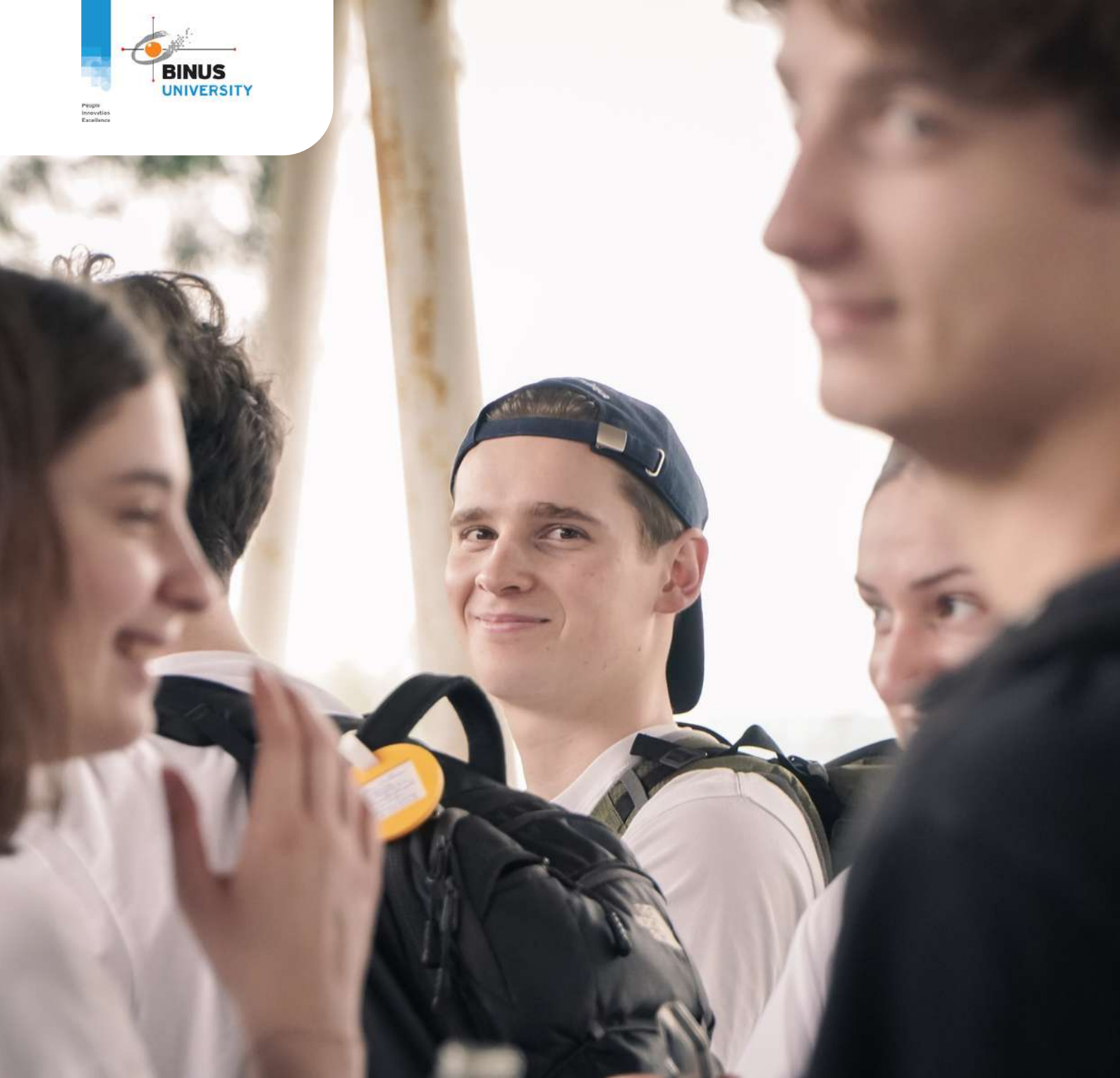

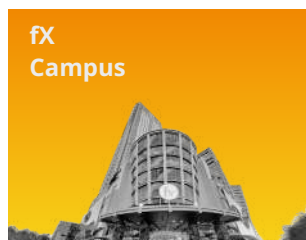

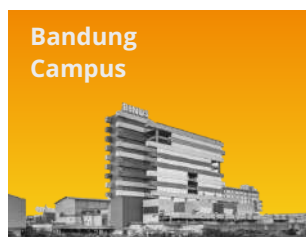

Academic Transcript:

Upon completion of the program, your academic transcript will be issued through the iMobilio app, making it easy for both you and your home university coordinator to access.

The transcript will be available on:

- Odd/Fall Semester: March 2026
- Even/Spring Semester: August 2026

Nomination Procedure

Selection Criteria:

- Must be an active student at a home university
- Must have completed at least 1 year of study at the home university
- Minimum age: 18 years old
- Minimum GPA: 2.75 out of 4.00 (or 70% out of 100%).

Language Requirement*:

Applicants must meet **one** of the following English proficiency requirements:

- IELTS: minimum score of 6.0
- TOEFL:
 - Paper-based: 550
 - Computer-based: 213
 - Internet-based: 79
- PTE Academic: minimum score of 50
- MUET: minimum Band 5
- or an official letter from the home university confirming that the medium of instruction is in English.

** Students holding passports from Australia, Canada, New Zealand, the United Kingdom, and the United States of America are considered native English speakers and are exempt from submitting English proficiency documents.*

Tuition Fee:

Students from partner universities joining the student exchange/study abroad program are exempt from admission and tuition fees.

Students from non-partner institutions are subject to applicable fees. Please contact our Inbound Team for more information.

Application and Nomination Procedures:

To apply for the student exchange or study abroad program, students must first contact the International Office at their home university. The home university must then officially nominate the student to BINUS University by submitting the nomination form via this link:

Application Procedure

Required Documents:

- Letter of enrolment from the home university
- Letter of academic recommendation
- Copy of official academic transcript
- Copy of English language proficiency test result (issued within the last two years)
- Passport biodata page (with at least 2 years of validity from the date of application)
- Applicants' Declaration*
- Statement of Purpose*
- Statement of Non-Political Involvement and Non-Working*
- Financial Statement*
- Health Statement (written in English) from a doctor (must clearly state that the student is in good health) or Basic Medical Report*
- Passport-sized photo (red or blue background)
- Domicile Letter*
- Proof of Health Insurance

Visa and Insurance

Visa Application*:

All international students are required to apply for an E30B Visa for Study Purposes, which allows entry into Indonesia and participation in academic activities.

BINUS University will act as your visa sponsor and will assist with the application process for study:

Students are responsible for covering the visa and limited stay permit processing fees, which are payable to BINUS University.

** Detail instruction will be given in the Letter of Conditional Acceptance.*

Health Insurance:

All international students must have valid health insurance that is accepted in Indonesia and covers the full duration of the program.

Your insurance policy should include:

- Medical treatment
- Hospitalization
- Emergency services
- Coverage for unforeseen events such as illness or injury

Please ensure your provider confirms that your policy is valid in Indonesia and offers sufficient coverage for all medical needs.

Friendly Support Programs

Airport Pick Up Service:

A complimentary airport transfer service is available for international students on a designated arrival date, from Soekarno-Hatta International Airport (CGK) to BINUS Square Hall of Residence.

iBuddy+ Program:

Incoming international students will be paired with our iBuddy+ volunteers—BINUS University students who are ready to help you adjust to life at the university and settle into Jakarta and Indonesian culture.

- Please bring a copy of your passport, ITAS, and IDR 100,000 in cash for the initial deposit and administrative fees.
- You can get your account, debit card, and mobile banking set up on the same day.
