Students should prepare and upload all the supporting document of application through the system: Statement of Purpose / Motivation letter; Latest Academic Report/Transcript; Student ID Card/Personal ID Card; English Proficiency Certificate Valid Passport (Identity Page); Formal Recent Photo; and Proof of Full Coverage Health Insurance Plan			

Course Lists offered	Updated in the online application portal. Students can mix the course choices from 2 (two) faculties only. Max 22 ITB credit for Bachelor level, and 12 ITB credit for Graduate level students. Faculty where more course credit taken by the student will be the host faculty, and the other will be the co-host. Note the below when selecting course: - S1 code refers to Undergraduate course level, and S2 refers to Master level courses. - The 1st two letters in the course code refer to the faculty. For all courses offered by the business School begin with code MMxxxx or MBxxxx and MKxxxx, so other than that, it refers to other faculties. - the digit number also refers to the course level (S1 = 1-4, for instance: MB3133, MK2002; S2=5-6, , for instance: MB5101, MM5002)

<p>Accommodation</p>	<p>Students are responsible for finding accommodation by themselves. ITB has a limited number of accommodations, there are rooms at ITB dormitory. The reservation in the Itb dormitory is handled through the host faculty at ITB at least one month before arrival date and according to the room availability.</p> <p>All private housings, and apartments are owned and managed by 3rd parties. Some recommended hotels and guest houses nearby for temporary stay are suggested: Sapadia Guest house ; Beehive Hotel; House Sangkuriang Bandung. For long-term stay there are recommended residence or apartments : SkyCity Home , Parahyangan Residence Apartment, Beverly Dago Apartment, Dago Butik Apartment, Galeri Ciumbuleuit Apartment</p> <p>Most all housings are managed by a 3rd party. You can also consider staying in an apartment which has better facilities. <p>Entry Visa and Stay Permit</p>	
<p>To enter Indonesia as a student at Institut Teknologi Bandung (ITB), you are required to apply for Study Permit (SP) & C-316 Visa or Limited Stay Visa (VITAS). Usually taking 2 weeks to process, Study Permit is issued by the Directorate General of Higher Education, Research, and Technology (Ministry of Education, Culture, Research, and Technology) in Jakarta. The International Relations Office ITB (IRO ITB), or the Division of International Partnerships under the Bureau of Partnerships ITB., will help you in the process. After IRO ITB receives all required documents, it takes about 2-3 months until your VITAS is issued.</p> <p>After you have arrived in Indonesia, the following are required to be processed (applicable to all with VITAS):</p> <p>Indonesian Police Report Letter (or STM) Limited Stay Permit (or ITAS), which is converted from your VITAS Temporary Residential Card (or SKTT) Change of Address (only if applicable) New Passport Registration (only if applicable)</p> <p>The following are the required documents to process your Study Permit and VITAS:</p> <p>Study Permit documents required:</p> <p>Letter of Acceptance from ITB</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • An Academic Report/Transcript • A Curriculum Vitae/Resume • A letter of Declaration stating that you will a) obey Indonesian rules and laws and b) will not involve in any work activities • A letter of Sponsorship or of Financial guarantee • If sponsored by an institution, please present the letter or proof of funding; • Health Declaration/Report, signed by a medical doctor within a maximum of 2 months before applying / (Health Certificate) • A color scan of valid Passport (full identity page): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 18-month passport validity remaining to apply for a 6-month SP and KITAS (Limited Stay Permit Visa) - 24-month passport validity remaining to apply for a 12-month SP and KITAS - 36-month passport validity remaining to apply for a 24-month SP and KITAS <p>(So, if your passport nearing expiration, we recommend that you have it renew to the maximum time allowable before you begin applying procedures.)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • formal photos (no-tshirt) – red background • Once the Study Permit is issued, the VITAS will be processed. <p>VITAS documents required:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Guarantee Letter (to be processed by ITB) • Colored Scan of Valid Passport (ID page) • Colored scan of front/cover passport • Proof of Sufficient Funds (at least USD 2.000) /bank statement • Health Insurance (for the period of stay in Indonesia) • Formal photos (no-tshirt) (colored, in jpeg, size 100-200 kb), white background, taken within the last 6 months • Covid-19 Vaccine Certificate; • Travel Insurance (covering covid-19 treatment, if testing positive after arrival in Indonesia); • Certificate or Statement of Good Conduct in English (a letter issued by home university or employer – with letterhead, confirming that you behaved well and/or has not been involved in any criminal activity. <p>Send all the documents to iro@itb.ac.id to start the process of Study Permit and VITAS.
