Almaty Management University is an entrepreneurial, socially responsible university striving to become more comprehensive and research oriented. In 2024, we celebrated 35 years in the education market, we are the oldest private university in the country, the first business school of the Republic of Kazakhstan, pioneer of business education in CIS. Since our establishment in 1988 AlmaU has taken the path of bringing innovative programs and projects to the market, developing an entrepreneurial spirit and a sense of social responsibility among students, faculty and impacted communities.

Today, AlmaU is a large community of successful alumni, creative students, faculty and partners. We broadcast the entrepreneurial mindset all over Central Asia, supporting economic growth through education.

The University team sets a clear goal of making a meaningful contribution to the development of Kazakhstan via fruitful cooperation with the business, government and society. In its operations AlmaU incorporates the UN SDGs, through following the UN Academic Impact, UN Global Compact and UN PRME principles and initiatives.



72% of undergraduate students study in the Russian language, 15% - in Kazakh, 13% - in English. Postgraduate studies are delivered mostly in Russian, however, the Global EMBA program run jointly with AMS is an English-language program.

Students from all language cohorts have the option of spending one semester or a year abroad at a partner university. In the 2024-2025 academic year, AlmaU had more than 100 outgoing students and about 15 incoming students. On top of that, in last couple of years we had several short-term educational projects and welcomed groups of students from USA (Lehigh University) and Russia (GSOM SPbU). AlmaU welcomes foreign students for internships: in 2023-2024 - 1 student from University of St. Andrews (UK), in 2024-2025 - 1 student from Cambridge University (UK), and we are expecting a student from Bauhaus University, Weimar (Germany) to come in 2025-206 for a 1-year internship in English and Russian speaking environment. All students interested in studying abroad undergo a selection process that includes submitting documents and an interview with university staff and faculty. As the rate of outgoing student mobility grows, we are looking to expand our partner network. MBA and DBA students typically participate in one or two international modules during their studies. Master's and PhD students, as well as research grant holders, frequently pursue scientific internships abroad.

### **Global Recognition**

**AlmaU** has the following accreditations: AMBA, BGA, IQA CEEMAN, FIBAA, IQAA, IAAR. University is also accredited by international professional certification agencies ACCA, CIMA and KAUP IPMA. The MBA program of the **AlmaU** Graduate School of Business "Financial Engineering" was internationally accredited by the Global Association of Risk Professionals GARP.

AlmaU ranks #1 among the leading humanitarian and economic universities of Kazakhstan in the National IQAA Ranking in 2025. University's impact within society and development of social responsibility has been evaluated by Times Higher Education Impact Ranking, where AlmaU is ranked 1001-1500 in 2025. The General MBA program of AlmaU ranks 251+ among the best business schools in the world according to QS World University Rankings, top 42 among Asian business schools and #24 in the ranking of the world's best joint programs in QS Executive MBA Rankings. AlmaU has the Eduniversal 4 Palmes of Excellence Award – Top Business School with Significant International Influence and is in the top 3 best business schools in the Central Asian zone of the Eduniversal Top Business Schools world ranking in 2017, 2019 and 2024.

As a part of their study abroad programs the exchange students come to AlmaU from partner universities in France, Russia, Kyrgyzstan, United States, Spain, Austria, China, Turkey, Czech Republic.



AlmaU promotes diversity and multi-cultural interaction and offers international students support services: visa and registration, airport pick-up and accommodation search upon request, speaking clubs, orientation weeks, sport and event clubs.

AlmaU attracts international experts for administrative, education, project development and scientific activities. Foreign teachers and researchers from Spain, Türkiye, Russia, Italy, Korea and other countries run lectures on core and language programs. The University develops staff and faculty mobility programs (including Erasmus+), as well as visiting professors and PhD supervising programs.

Course information/ Syllabus	The syllabus will be shared before the beginning of each semester (will be sent to incoming international students by email).	
Course selection	Students select their preferred courses (unless a different procedure is determined by bilateral agreements between sending and receiving institutions). The registration for chosen courses will be handled remotely by student coordinators. <b>Students have only two weeks after the start of the semester to change courses.</b> The list of courses is sent to the incoming student in advance.  A full semester workload for students is 30 ECTS credits.

Almaty Management University (AlmaU) uses the ECTS grading system. The number of ECTS credits for each course reflects the total number of hours a student is expected to devote to the course (in the form of lectures, homework, reading, essays, consultations, seminars, etc.). Since 2021, AlmaU undergraduate programs switched to 3-year length of study with 240- ECTS in total. About 90 ECTS credits are attached to the workload of a full-time year of formal learning (academic year) on undergraduate level and the associated learning outcomes during first two years of study. The 3rd year makes about 60 ECTS. At AlmaU, 1 ECTS credit is equal to 30 hours of student total workload.

Students' academic achievements are evaluated in points on a 100-point scale, in a letter system with a digital equivalent (positive grades from "A" to "D", and "unsatisfactory" - "FX" and "F"). Grades of midterm 1 and midterm 2 of academic performance constitute 60% of the final assessment of academic achievements on the discipline, grade of the final exam constitutes 40% of the final grade on the discipline. The grade "F" (Fail) "unsatisfactory" is used when students miss more than 30% of the total number of classroom hours in the discipline.

	BEFORE ARRIVAL		
Visa support	Almaty Management University supports international students with application proceedings to get a study visa through the provision of invitation letters and registration numbers from the Department of Consular Service of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Almaty ( <a href="http://mfa.gov.kz/en/">http://mfa.gov.kz/en/</a> ). Incoming students should also visit the website of the Consulate General of Kazakhstan in their countries to learn more about the documents required for visa application (medical insurance, validity of passport, 2 passport-sized photos, application form of host university).		
Accommodation (Off-campus)	AlmaU does not provide any accommodation on campus.  AlmaU supports international students in their search for accommodation, providing personal advice, and useful information to ensure that students can quickly find a place to call their own. Usually, prices start from \$500–600/month depending on whether the choice is a private or a shared flat. Shared accommodation can be almost half as expensive. The need for accommodation assistance should be mentioned in the students' application forms.		
Insurance	Health insurance is mandatory for all international students throughout their term of enrollment at AlmaU. Proof of medical coverage must be submitted by the student before their arrival and at the start of the exchange period (it shall be attached to application documents).  Please, note that valid international health insurance coverage is also one of the legal requirements while applying for Kazakhstani visa.

Welcome on arrival	AlmaU International Office and University staff will welcome international students and help them to settle into their new life, through a buddy program; providing them with information materials, like e.g. Student Handbook; and organizing touristic trips inside and outside of the city.		
Orientation week – COMPULSORY for all Incoming Exchange Students	AlmaU Academic Mobility Office provides Introduction Day programs for all international students a few days before the start of each Semester. This compulsory session aims to integrate international students into their new environment, inform them about university regulations and administrative matters (visa, residence permit and registration, health insurance, banking, mobile and internet providers, accommodation, transportation, student cards, academic expectations and standards).		
Notes for foreigners staying	According to the university's internal rules, foreigners must report to our visa officer before and after each trip in Kazakhstan and abroad, as this is also the requirement of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Kazakhstan. Violation leads to fines and deportation.
