On-Campus Housing	<p>Single Rooms: \$661-\$933 per month*† Double Rooms: \$450-480 per month*†</p> <p>*Students must purchase a meal plan if staying on-campus. †Students that live in Residence Hall 1 during the academic year or Spring Semester are eligible to receive a free season pass to Powder Mountain Ski Resort with the “Skimester” Program.</p>
Email	<p>Students should apply for housing AS SOON AS POSSIBLE as housing cannot be guaranteed the closer we get to the start of the semester. Off-Campus Housing	<p>\$300-800 per month, depending on the room/apartment/house rented. Typically rented for a full 12 month contract. Some offer semester contracts or 8 month contracts, but are rare. Single semester contracts go FAST! Try to find an apartment that is furnished. Other	
Cost of Living	\$300-600 per month. Includes food, transportation, and various other costs. Cost of living varies between students’ lifestyles. Cost is an estimate.
Public Transportation	All students will receive a free Utah Transit Authority (UTA) pass to be used for buses throughout Ogden, Frontrunner train to Salt Lake City and Provo, and the Trax rail system in Salt Lake City.
Insurance	Health insurance is required for all international students and scholars in an F or J visa category. Students will be automatically enrolled each semester in the Student Health Insurance Plan (SHIP) when they register for classes. Embassy or government-sponsored students must provide proof of health insurance coverage in order to be exempted from automatic enrollment. International Students may be eligible for an insurance waiver if they meet the following criteria: Coverage must be continuous (no break or termination) for the entire academic year or

	semester, U.S.-based employer-sponsored plan as a dependent under a spouse or parent, Employer-sponsored coverage through employment, spouse or parent, The deductible must be \$500 or less per policy year, International students may not waive with insurance from their home country.
Extra Fees	Some courses have “Electronic Course Material” that is required for the course and costs between \$30-100 . Other courses will have course fees between \$5-100 . Students will need to purchase their own textbooks, either through the Campus Bookstore, Amazon, Chegg, CampusBookRentals, or other sites.
