i. Acceptance procedures

Upon successful application, you will receive an Offer Letter. The letter will list how to accept the offer and the required fees (if any) you need to pay. Accept your offer as soon as possible.

ii. Apply for a Student Visa

Visa Application Procedures

Upon your offer acceptance, UCSI will apply to EMGS on your behalf for student visa. Once you receive your visa, come to UCSI University, Malaysia.

- Pay RM 2,180 (USD\$ 530) visa application fees.
- You will be notified when the visa is approved. Download eVisa Approval Letter from the EMGS webpage.
- Go to the Malaysia Embassy in your home country for a SEV "Single Entry Visa".

i. Accommodation arrangements

Please make sure that you have booked and confirmed your accommodation before arrival, either with a counsellor or through your own resources. Requests upon arrival may not be entertained.

ii. RT-PCR Covid-19 Test

You are required to undergo the RT-PCR Covid-19 Test three (3) days before travelling to Malaysia. The RT-PCR Covid-19 test result must be translated in ENGLISH so that the respective authorities in Malaysia can inspect it.

iii. Online payment for the quarantine and the Covid-19 Screening Test

Please complete the online payment for the quarantine and the Covid-19 Screening Test through MySafeTravel (www.safetravel.myeg.com.my) / MyQr application by MyEG (www.myeg.gov.my) and provide the payment slip at the international entry point upon arrival.

iv. Arrival notification

Please complete the *Immigration Clearance and Arrival Information Form in IIS Student Portal*. Ensure that you submit the completed form at least SEVEN (7) working days before your departure date.

Students are required to download the MySejahtera app from the iOS App Store, Google Play Store or Huawei AppGallery to complete all the required information three (3) days prior to the arrival date.

	i. Mandatory Quarantine	
	All international students arriving in Malaysia are subjected to fourteen (14) days quarantine at designated government quarantine stations regardless of whether they are vaccinated or not. The quarantine period of 14 days will be extended to twenty-one (21) days (7 days' extension), depending on the risk assessment conducted on the students on day 14 of the quarantine
