



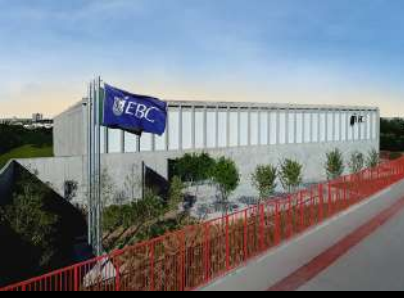

## NOMINATION PROCEDURE

Home Institutions must nominate students using the official EBC Nomination Form (Excel format), sent by email to: [internationaloffice@ebc.edu.mx](mailto:internationaloffice@ebc.edu.mx)

Each nomination must include:

- Student's full name (as in passport)
- Date of birth
- Email address
- Field of study
- Level of study (Undergraduate/Graduate)
- Semester of exchange (Fall 2026 / Spring 2027)

After nomination is confirmed, students will receive instructions to complete the online application.



## ONLINE APPLICATION

Students must complete the official online application form after nomination.

All required documents must be uploaded in PDF format.

# ACADEMIC INFORMATION & REQUIREMENTS



## LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION

Courses are offered mostly in Spanish.

Recommended Spanish level:

- Undergraduate students: minimum B2
- Graduate students: minimum C1

Selected courses in English are available only at the Mexico City Campus.  
All international students must take the Spanish course.



## REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- Transcript of Records
- Proof of Spanish proficiency (minimum B1)
- Two recommendation letters
- Copy of valid passport (minimum 6 months validity)
- Motivation letter
- Passport-size photo
- Curriculum Vitae
- Course Registration Form

## VISA INFORMATION

Students staying more than six months must obtain a Mexican student visa prior to arrival.

This procedure cannot be completed once in Mexico.
