We seek to train entrepreneurial professionals who are distinguished in the field of organizations **for their knowledge, for their work and for their being.**

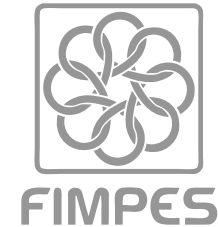
We hope that **educational excellence** is the basis of our work and with that seek the progress of our community.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- Transcript of records.
- 2 recommendation letters from two different professors.
- Copy of minimum 6-month Valid Passport.
- Motivation letter.
- Passport size photo (not from mobile/cellphone).
- Student CV.
- Preselect Course form.
- Proof of level of Spanish (ELYTE or DELE), minimum B1 under the European Framework of Languages.
- Proof of English level.

ENROLLMENT, ACCOMMODATION AND IMMIGRATION.

Students who successfully complete the application form and send all documents will be considered to come to EBC.

Our Campus Coordinators will be in contact with your students once all the students have been accepted in each Campus. They will provide them information about enrollment, accommodation and migration processes.

Students should present the following documents upon arrival:

- **International Medical Insurance**
- **Mexican student visa (only for students staying more than 6 months or doing an internship).**

Students must apply for the Mexican student visa before arriving to Mexico, without exception; once in Mexico this procedure cannot be done.
