About ITAM

ITAM is a private higher educational institution, which operates on a non-profit, secular basis and without political affiliation.

It was founded in 1946 by a group of Mexicans led by Don Raúl Baillères to contribute to Mexico's overall development through human and professional training, teaching and scientific research.

Mission

ITAM seeks to contribute to the individual's comprehensive education and to develop a freer, more just, and prosperous society.

It also aims to become a community in its fullest

sense, an institution of excellence and academic freedom, and a high-quality autonomous research center.

Location

One seat: Mexico City. Two campuses: Río Hondo, for undergraduate and engineering degrees, and Santa Teresa, for post-graduate and executive development studies.



Basic principles

ITAM acknowledges three basic principles as standards for its activities:

University autonomy, understood as self-governance on its internal regulatory issues, namely academic, legal, administrative, and financial.

Academic freedom, with the shared responsibility it entails, essential to fulfill its university functions.

Communality, by which all its members join in the common pursuit of their objectives and the institution's improvement.

Educational philosophy

ITAM perceives human beings as free and social individuals, engaged in the pursuit of human development and progress, and as individuals essentially devoted to the quest for truth and righteousness.

Hence, education, in general, tends to improve the lives of human beings through the enrichment of their best values, their growth as individuals, the development of their awareness and the increase of their civic capabilities. It also acknowledges their civic duty. As a result, our students become increasingly loyal to Mexico, to its values and traditions, which are understood as collective heritage.


The arte of *teaching*

Physical health

Both of our campuses have a team of professionals who offer medical services to our community. When necessary, these physicians will channel patients to laboratory testing or to the appropriate specialists.

A two-week **health campaign is organized each semester**, offering the following services:

- Tetanus and diphtheria vaccines
- Testing for high blood pressure, overweight and diabetes
- STD testing
- Promotion of family planning methods
- Courses on highway safety, CPR and first aid.

Mental health

The Under Department of Mental Health Services offers psychological and psychiatric support and promotes initiatives on stress management and addiction prevention.

It also has the support of **Línea Origen-ITAM and Casa Grana**, allied institutions that expand mental health services to the university community:

- Free and professional emotional care
- Immediate emotional care

Career Services facilitates and promotes contacts between students and alumni with **high-level organizations** in both the private and public sector, as well as with national and international institutions operating in the Third Sector, **offering them more competitive professional opportunities** in keeping with their interests, knowledge and skills.




