MINIMUM LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT

Spanish is desired, but not mandatory. If courses taught in English are chosen, students must render a certificate of English level B2.



VISA PROCEDURES



Students from non-restricted countries, applying for one semester, do not need a student visa. Students applying for more than one semester and students from restricted countries should visit the closest Mexican Consulate or Embassy to apply for a student visa.
