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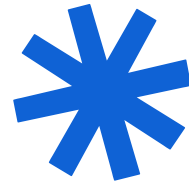

Academic Calendar

- **Fall** (1st Semester): August 10th – December 8th, 2026 (Exam period included).
- **Spring** (2nd Semester): January 11th – May 18th, 2027 (Exam period included).

Spanish Language Course

We strongly recommend exchange students whose native language is not Spanish, to enroll in the Spanish Language Course (6 credits).

Anahuac Mayab Credits


- Minimum: 18 Mexican credits.
- Maximum: 66 Mexican credits.

Exchange students usually take from 24 up to 30 credits (most of the courses are 6 credits).

Language proficiency

Courses in Spanish: Certificate B1 or a document issued by the University Language department of the home institution.

Courses in English: Certificate B2 or a document issued by the University Language department of the home institution.



Accommodation

Students may arrange accommodation by renting houses or apartments, either individually or shared, according to their preferences and needs. Mayab Buddies will provide guidance and support in securing suitable options in safe areas within reach of the university shuttle service

International Health Insurance

All incoming exchange students must take the University Health Insurance Plan.

Coverage by any other insurance plan will NOT allow the students to be exempted from our plan.

Insurance is charged by term; students will pay it directly, after receiving their acceptance letter.
