Application Requirements	Student on transfer credit: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fully completed UVM Application Form signed by the applicant and the sending university • Official transcript • Letter of motivation (in English or Spanish) • Copy of passport • Copy of health insurance
Language requirements	Students on transfer credit: All or most classes are conducted in Spanish, therefore students are expected to have a sufficient command of the Spanish language to be capable of understanding, making oral presentations, writing reports and taking exams.



Recommended Arrival Dates	One week before classes begin to set up course schedule and find housing.
Level of Study for Incoming Students	Undergraduate Transfer credit students: At least 1 year of studies with at least the equivalent of 90 credits in Business.
Living / Prospective costs	Budget = approximately 250€ housing Groceries = 50 EUROS weekly UVM BUS= 15 euros for 12 rides
