RESIDENCE PERMIT

Students from EU/EEA countries do not need to apply for a residence permit, but must register with the police after arrival in Norway.

Nationals of non-EEA countries must apply for a student residence permit. One of the requirements is that the applicant must document access to approx. NOK 121 220 for one academic year (10 months) or NOK 60 610 for one semester.
