Inward Exchange



Eligibility Criteria

- Students must have proficiency in English.
- Students must have successfully completed at least one year of education with good academic standing within a relevant field of study at their home institution.

Exchange partners nominate their selected students via email. All nominated students will receive an acceptance email/letter with the application instructions and practical information about the exchange programme at LUMS. Students may complete the application form and send it back via email and courier along with the required documents as follows.

Cost of Living

The cost of living per semester (5 months) is approximately PKR 221,445 i.e. (€740 or \$777). This is just an estimate of the cost since books and food are bought by the exchange students themselves. Below is a general overview of your cost of living on campus at LUMS per semester. These estimated costs can vary from person to person and depends upon the lifestyle of the individual.
