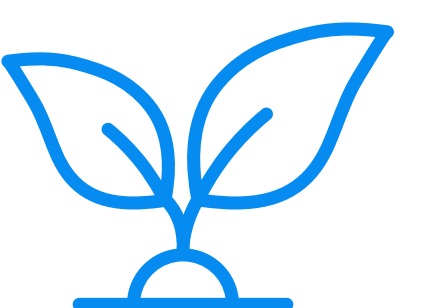
Why Peru?

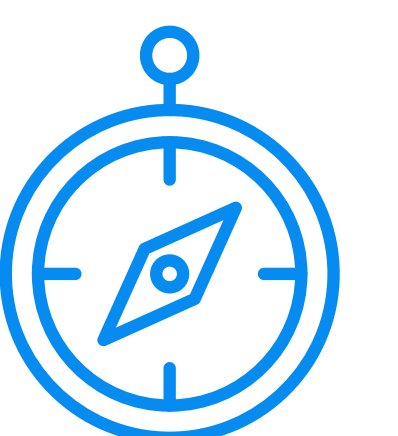

Academic Calendar

Courses follow **flexible academic terms** rather than traditional semesters, starting at different times throughout the year. There are **no centralized exam periods**, as assessments are determined by each course.

1. Nomination Process

Partner institutions must send nominations to **centruminternacional@pucp.edu.pe** including the student's **first name, last name, nationality, and email address**.

Once received, the International Office will contact the nominated students directly with the application instructions.

2. Application Process

After nomination, students receive an email with instructions to complete the application and submit required documents, including **CV, passport copy, transcript, photo, language certificate, and the online application form**.

3. Acceptance

Once all documents have been reviewed and approved, students will receive their official **Letter of Acceptance** from CENTRUM PUCP.

Academic Details

COURSES

Students may take courses from different graduate programs (e.g., MBA and MSc) and choose classes in **English or Spanish**.

Courses cover key business areas such as finance, marketing, strategy, innovation, sustainability, entrepreneurship, leadership, and digital transformation.

CREDITS

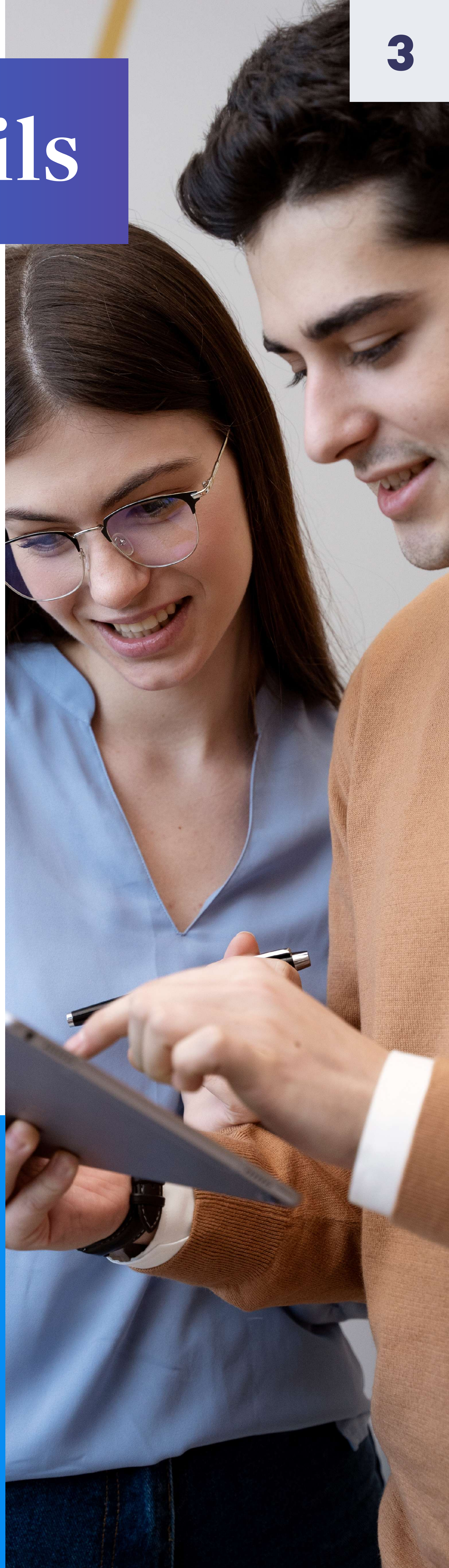
1 PUCP credit equals 2.5 ECTS. Each credit corresponds to 8 sessions of 1.5 hours each.

GRADING SYSTEM

Grades range from 0 to 20, with 11 as the minimum passing grade and 20 as the highest distinction.

Important Considerations

- Most courses are offered in Spanish, with a limited selection available in English.
- If a student fails a course, they may have the option to retake it in a condensed format, covering the associated cost.
- Courses are delivered in in-person, online, and blended (hybrid) formats.

Note: Costs may vary depending on lifestyle and may be lower when students share accommodation, transportation, or meals with other students.



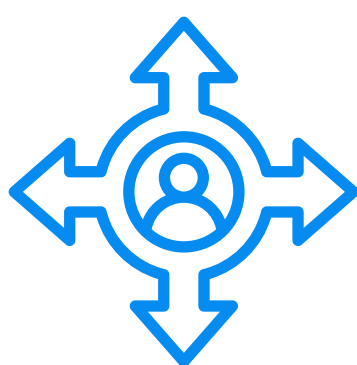
Visa Process

Students must have **mandatory all-inclusive** international health insurance covering their entire stay in Peru.



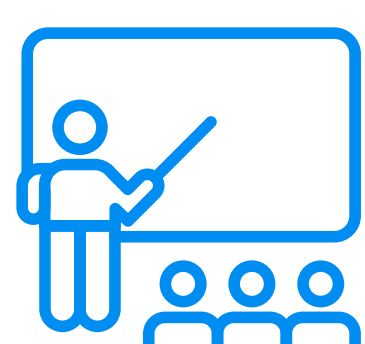

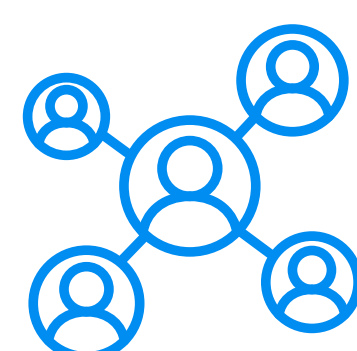
