
OUR CAMPUSES

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

The prospective student or their coordinator is required to send the following:

- A formal photo of the student*
- A photo of the student in their favorite place*
- Application form
- Updated resume in Spanish
- Transcripts from their university
- School letter or language certificate (Spanish level B1)
- A recommendation letter from their university
- A copy of the student's passport
- International insurance for their stay abroad (Repatriation, hospitalization, medical expenses, civil liability, household insurance)
- Introduction and Expectation form


