


Centrum PUCP

The Pontificia Universidad Católica del Perú (PUCP) was founded in 1917 as a non-profit private institution dedicated to the education of undergraduate and graduate students. Centrum PUCP is the graduate business school of PUCP and was founded in a new facility outside the main campus of PUCP, in 2001.

Centrum PUCP is the first and only Business School in Perú to obtain 4 accreditations (AACSB, EQUIS, AMBA, BGA), and is now among the 8 Business Schools in Latin America that have obtained these accreditations.

Application Procedure

The prospective student or his/her coordinator should send us the application documents beforehand, including:

- | **Application form.**
- | **Current resume in Spanish.**
- | **Transcript of the home institution.**
- | **School letter or language certificate (Spanish level B1).**
- | **Recommendation letter from your university.**
- | **Photocopy of the student's passport.**
- | **Health Insurance for your stay abroad.**

Language requirements

The majority of courses are taught in Spanish. Students who choose these courses must provide a proof of minimum intermediate language level.

Application Deadlines

The application deadlines for exchange programs are:

Term	Application Deadline
Fall Term (March 2024)	October 31st 2023
Spring Term (September 2024)	February 28th 2024

**Our classes are divided into cycles, not semesters. Classes start all year round, at different times. Therefore, foreign students are welcome at any time.*



Grading System

At Centrum PUCP grades range is from 0 to 20. The lower passing grade is 10.50/20.

Attendance is mandatory. Each non-attendance will be taken into consideration at the end of the course. If the student accumulates more than 25% of non-attendance, the grade will be automatically dropped to 05/20 in case the student has attended two sessions at least. Otherwise, the grade will automatically drop to 0/20.

*1 Centrum PUCP credit = 2.5 ECTS
= 12 chronological hours
= 16 academic hours



Course selection

Once a student submits their learning agreement, they can request one change to their course selection.

It is important that the student choose their final courses at least two months before the start of their exchange. Once the student chooses a course, his enrollment is requested and a work group is assigned to him.
