III. ADMISSION PROCESS | SEMESTER IN LIMA 2025-01

1. NOMINATION

Partner Universities will receive an email with the link to nominate their students. Please, fill in with the student's information:



A confirmation email will be immediately sent to the student email address with the online application. On this page, they will need to upload their documentation.

2. APPLICATION

Students will need to complete the Application Form and submit the following documents:

01 Digital Photo (only JPG format)	Transcript of Records*
Copy of Passport*	Declaration of Financial Statement
Curriculum Vitae*	International Medical Insurance Coverage

3. REVISION PROCESS

Once the application has been submitted, one of our executives will proceed to review your application. In case there were any observations, a message will be sent to the student's email address.

If the documents are complete and correctly submitted with all the requirements, students will receive their **USIL Acceptance Letter.**

4. VISA

The student exchange visa procedure is initiated by USIL with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. For this process, students will need to send their flight tickets (arrival/departure) where the student's data can be viewed and the dates are within the period requested and insured, please send them to the email: inboundmobility@usil.edu.pe



IV. DOCUMENTS TO APPLY FOR THE STUDENT EXCHANGE VISA PROCESS

		Passport (valid for 6 months after finishing your stay)
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		Flight ticket or travel reservation where the student's data can be viewed and the dates are within the period requested and insured. If it is not possible to attach a ticket or book the return flight, you can send an a davit in which you agree to leave from Peruvian territory at the end of the requested period.
\$		Bank statement proving the financial solvency of the student or a document in which the student or persons of whom he or she is in a dependent relationship insure their financial support during their stay in the country.
		Official Transcript of Records, a copy of the document certifying the student's membership in their Home University (certificate issued by the Home Institution, record card or other).

Also, International Students will have to confirm the country and the city where they will be able to pick up their Student Exchange Visa.

V. ADMISSION PROCESS | SEMESTER IN LIMA 2025-01

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

Students are required to have a **B2 level proficiency to take courses taught in English.** In case the student would like to take courses taught in Spanish, they will be asked to complete the Spanish Placement Test (SPT) through an evaluation in order to know their Spanish Level.

SPANISH PLACEMENT TEST

If the student is not native in Spanish, they will need to take the test.

The test applies for students who:

- Want to take courses taught in Spanish.
- Want to take the Spanish Language course; but do not want to start from the Elemental Spanish class (already have any previous knowledge) and do not have a certificate or a transcript

NOTE: In case you have a Spanish Certificate, you can send it to **inboundmobility@usil.edu.pe** and the Language Department will place you to corresponding level.

ENROLLMENT PROCESS

Students will receive an email with important information and guidelines to start the Online Registration Process, they will need to create and access to the INFOSIL account.

ASSISTED ENROLLMENT

Our USIL International Team will provide the Shift Assisted Enrollment Service according to the first letter of the student's Last Name. If you need any direct support to register your courses, you can enter the corresponding schedule to support you.

*REQUIREMENTS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS WISHING TO TAKE COOKING AND/OR BEVERAGE COURSES

- 1. Culinary and Language courses allow absences up to 20%.
- 2. Students must follow the dress code rules 100% (includes chef shoes and not slippers), and they must sign a commitment of compliance.
- 3. Bring your own utensils to class, otherwise you will have to purchase them at the university.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION (ESTIMATE)

MONEY EXCHANGE

Exchange a small amount at the airport just in case SOLES are needed. You should bring Euros or US Dollars. We recommend exchanging some at the airport. Also, VISA and Mastercard are widely accepted and used in most establishments. However, for buying souvenirs we would recommend having some cash.

Exchange at the bank or find a designated government official wearing the vests indicating they are official workers to exchange money. There are many authorized Money Exchange establishments in Miraflores and in La Molina.

LOCAL CURRENCY

There are bills with denominations of 10, 20, 50, 100, and 200 soles.



There are also coins of 10,20 and 50 cents as well as 1,2 and 5 soles.
