Languages	Spanish. English: Management, Economics, Engineering, Marketing, and International Business courses.
Spanish Language Requirements	An official language certification is not required; although it is strongly recommended to have a Spanish B2 level (written and spoken).
Exchange Participants	Undergraduate and graduate students.
Eligibility	Home university selects the candidates and nominates them for the student exchange program.
Number of Exchange Students	As agreed in the bilateral agreement. In case more students are interested in studying at Ulima, please inform us.
Maximum Exchange Period	Students may participate in the student exchange program at Universidad de Lima for a period not to exceed one (1) year.

 - Application form signed by the international coordinator (downloadable from Mobility Online)

COURSE WORKLOAD

3-4 hours per week (class hours).



STANDARD NUMBER OF SEMESTERS TO COMPLETE A BACHELOR'S DEGREE

- Students must complete 209 credits in 10 semesters (5 years).
- Students who pursue the Law Undergraduate Program must complete 257 credits in 6 years.
- Students who pursue the Psychology Undergraduate Program must complete 237 credits in 6 years.



CREDIT SYSTEM

One Ulima credit is equivalent to one hour of theory classes per week throughout the semester or two hours of practical classes per week. The semester has 14 weeks of classes.

Courses may carry 2 to 4 credits depending on their level of difficulty. The Ulima credit is different from an ECTS credit. Some European partners use this equivalence: 1 Ulima credit = 1.5 ECTS.



GRADING SYSTEM

The grading system ranges from 0 to 20; any grade under 11 is considered a failing grade.

Course evaluations are conducted throughout the semester.

- Continuous evaluation 1: From week 1 to week 7 of classes
- Continuous evaluation 2: From week 9 to week 15 of classes

ISSUANCE OF TRANSCRIPTS

Transcripts are sent directly to the student around one (1) week after the end of the semester.



ACADEMIC ADVISING

An academic advisor will assist students during the enrollment process with the selection of courses. Students are allowed to make changes in their registration (add, change, withdraw courses) only up to the **first week of classes**.

HEALTH INSURANCE INFORMATION

Mandatory Health Insurance

Before their arrival, students must submit a copy of their international insurance policy acquired in their home country, which covers the entire duration of their stay as exchange students in Peru (from the day of their arrival in Lima until the date of departure to their country).

This insurance must include outpatient care, hospitalization and repatriation of remains through direct credit at private clinics in Peru. It must also include validity dates.

Please ask your insurance company for the list of private clinics in Lima that have an agreement with them and send it to us by email: uce_intercambio@ulima.edu.pe

VISA INFORMATION

Universidad de Lima will arrange an exchange visitor visa through the Peruvian Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

In order to start the process, exchange students must upload the information below to the Mobility Online platform **60 days before their arrival in Lima**:

- Copy of the air ticket to Lima (round trip)
- Copy of passport
- Accommodation address in Lima
- International health insurance
- Statement of solvency to travel to Peru (downloadable from Mobility Online)

Students will be notified when the visa is ready (one or two weeks before their arrival in Lima) so that they can pick it up at the Peruvian Embassy or Consulate in their countries. Please visit this website <http://www.consulado.pe/paginas/Inicio.aspx> to find the Peruvian Consulate according to your country.

This official visa is granted for 183 days, which is the period of one semester at Universidad de Lima. It is given exclusively for academic purposes; consequently, the return flight must be scheduled as follows:

- For students who will study in Spring semester 2025, before July 31, 2025.
- For students who will study in Fall semester 2025, before December 31, 2025.

Important note:

If students decide to extend their stay for one more semester, they must send an email to uce_intercambio@ulima.edu.pe to start the visa renovation process. Furthermore, students must communicate to the Immigration Officer if they decide to leave the country during their study period and mention that they hold a Peruvian study visa granted by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs—valid for leaving and returning to Peru.

ACCOMMODATION

As on-campus housing is not available at Universidad de Lima, students may choose among the accommodation option list attached to the Mobility Online application form. Students can request assistance, if needed.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

PALS PROGRAM

Each foreign student will be assisted before and during the exchange by a PALS partner, who will support them in their cultural and academic insertion. The program includes assistance in the official registration of courses and advice on the use of the Ulima App and the Blackboard platform.

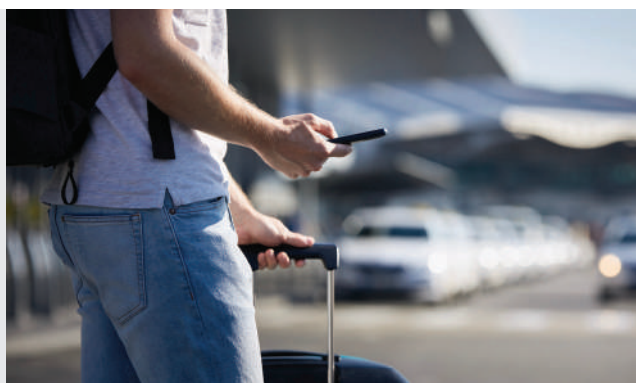
The objectives of the program are as follows:

AIRPORT PICKUP SERVICE

Free airport pickup service is provided for the day of arrival of students. Students must ask for this service at least two (2) weeks before their arrival date.
