Mandatory Health Insurance	<p>Before their arrival, students must submit a copy of their international insurance policy for the entire duration of their stay as exchange students (from the day of their arrival in Lima until the date of departure to their country). This insurance must include ambulatory attention, hospitalization, and bodies repatriate service through direct credit at private clinics in Peru. Please ask your insurance company for the list of private clinics in Lima that have an agreement with them and send it to us by email: Lchio@ulima.edu.pe</p>
COVID-19 Vaccine	<p>In order to access campus facilities, all students must be fully vaccinated for COVID 19. Proof of vaccination will have to be submitted to the International Program staff before arrival. In addition, we require a negative PCR test that has to be shown when the student enters the campus for the first time. The PCR test has to be done 48 hours before the visit to our institution.</p>
Visa	<p>Universidad de Lima will arrange an official exchange visa for exchange students, through the Peruvian Ministry of Foreign Affairs.</p> <p>In order to start the procedure, students shall submit the following information by email (Lchio@ulima.edu.pe) one and a half months before of their arrival in Lima:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Copy of flight ticket to Lima (round trip) - Copy of passport - Address of the student residence/house where the student will live in Lima. - International Health insurance - A statement of economic solvency to travel to Peru <p>We will notify students when the visa is ready (it takes one or two weeks before their arrival in Lima) so they can pick it up at the Peruvian Embassy/Consulate in their countries. Please visit this webpage: http://www.consulado.pe/paginas/Inicio.aspx in order to find the Peruvian Consulate according to your country.</p> <p>This official visa is granted for 183 days which is the period of one semester at the Universidad de Lima. The official visa is given exclusively for academic purposes; consequently, the return flight must be scheduled as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Students who will study in Winter 2022/2023 no further than December 31st, 2022. -Students who will study in Spring 2023 no further than, July 31st, 2023.
Typical credit load per course	3-4 hours per week (contact hours).
Standard number of semesters for completion of BA	<p>10 semesters (5 years), the students have to complete 209 credits. Students who pursue the Bachelor Degree in Law must complete 257 credits in 6 years.</p> <p>Students who pursue the Bachelor Degree in Psychology must complete 237 credits in 6 years.</p>

Credit system	One ULima credit is equivalent to one hour of taught classes a week throughout the semester, or two hours a week of practical classes. The semester has 14 weeks of classes. Courses could have from 2 to 4 credits depending on the level of difficulty. The ULima credit is different from an ECTS credit. Some European partners use this equivalence: 1 ULima credit = 1.5 ECTS.																		
Grading system at Universidad de Lima	The grading system ranges from 0 to 20; any grade under 11 is considered a failed mark. Grades are organized as follows: mid-semester exam (30%), academic performance-homework (30%), and final exam (40%). The academic performance totals the sum of different quizzes such as group works, research projects, exercises, and class participation.
