Language of instruction	English (80-100 courses per semester) Polish (majority of courses)
Required level of language ability	Level B2 (according to European standard CEFR) No particular certificate is required but language ability should be verified by the home University exchange coordinator
Required ECTS workload	Recommended 30 ECTS per semester (minimum 20 ECTS) 60 ECTS per academic year
Language courses available free of charge	Polish for beginners (1st and 2nd semester) German, French, Spanish and Russian - intermediate and advanced business language courses
Intensive English Course	2-weeks pre-semester intensive language course of English in September for interested students (level B2). Details will be sent to students in May



Accommodation

Accommodation options	Students declare the type of accommodation in the application form: • student dormitories owned by the University (only twin rooms) • private accommodation (private dormitories or rooms/ apartments) More information: https://ue.poznan.pl/en/incoming-exchange-students/
Accommodation equipment (University dormitories)	The rooms have furniture, bedding and blankets. The rooms have Internet cable connection available but there are no computers. The dormitories have kitchens equipped with fridges and ovens but there are no cooking pans nor dishes.

Approximate cost of accommodation per month

University's dormitories – 575 – 650 PLN (135 - 155 €)
Private room - 1000 – 1300 PLN (240 - 310 €)
Private studio/apartment – 1900 - 2800 PLN (450 - 665 €)

Booking procedure

Exchange students apply for accommodation in University's dormitories through application form. Confirmation of getting a place is sent in July/December by International Relations Office. Number of places is limited and getting the room is **not guaranteed**. Poznań University of Economics and Business does not act as an intermediary in the rental of private accommodation. Student should contact the chosen institution/landlord independently.

Pick-up service upon arrival/ Buddy System

The student mentors arranged by ESN UE Poznań meet the exchange students on arrival and provide support at the beginning of their stay in Poznań.
