WITHDRAWAL

To withdraw from the student exchange program, notify your home institution and copy LASALLE's Division of Quality & Planning and Global Engagement (DQPGE) at global_engagement@lasalle.edu.sg.

STUDY LEVEL

The Inbound Student Exchange programme is open to **Undergraduates** from our recognised Exchange Partner Institutions.

PROGRAMME DURATION

Study at LASALLE for one or two semesters. Each semester is about 16 weeks long, comprising of 7 Teaching weeks, 1 Project week, another 6 Teaching weeks and 2 Assessment weeks.

MODE OF STUDY

Full-time study on campus for the duration of the exchange.

PROGRAMME SELECTION AND RESTRICTIONS

Students should choose a programme that aligns with their field of study at their home institution. Approval is required from the home institution if you wish to pursue a discipline unrelated to your major. LASALLE will review and approve the selected discipline to ensure academic appropriateness.

SEMESTER WORKLOAD

You will be given a set list of modules to complete each semester based on your selected programme. The value of each semester is 60 LASALLE credits, which is the equivalent of 30 ECTS.

MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION

All programmes are delivered in **English only**.

SEMESTER GRADE REPORT

At the end of each semester, you can download your semester grade reports from the student learning portal. LASALLE will also send your official grade report to your home institution's International Office after each semester. Please be aware that interim transcripts are not issued, and all results are marked with "This is not an official transcript." The semester grade reports receive approval from the Institutional Board of Examiners at the end of each academic year.

APPLICATION TO ARRIVAL

01 NOMINATION

Apply through your home institution. Once nominated, you'll receive an email containing the application link and instructions to begin the application process.

02 APPLICATION ONLINE

SEM 1: MAR SEM 2: SEP

Complete the online application and upload all mandatory documents within the stipulated deadline (see page 4). Incomplete applications will result in processing delays.

03 ACCEPT OFFER

SEM 1: APR/MAY SEM 2: OCT/NOV

Upon approval of your application, the Admissions team will send you an online welcome package. Follow the instructions to accept the offer and apply for a Student's Pass (STP) before arriving.

STP application must be submitted **at least two months** and no more than three months before arrival

04 TRAVEL PLANS

It is recommended to book your flights and accommodation **only after** receiving the In-Principle Approval (IPA) letter, issued when the STP application is approved. You should also purchase travel insurance.

05 ARRIVE AT LASALLE

Arrive about a week before the semester commences. Attend the Orientation and begin classes.

The DQPGE team will arrange for a brief session to meet with you as well.

Get nominated by your home institution to exchange at LASALLE!

Direct applications are not accepted. Please note that you are required to be nominated by the international office of your home institution first before your application can be accepted. Nominees will receive an application link and information from DQPGE to start their application.

CHECK YOUR ELIGIBILITY

- ✓ My home university is LASALLE's partner institution
- ✓ I am a full-time, matriculated student at my home institution.
- ✓ I have been nominated by my home institution.
- ✓ I have completed at least one/two semesters of study at my home institution (please check with your home institution on the agreed study criteria).
- ✓ I have attained reasonably good results
- ✓ I am proficient in the English language

DOCUMENTS TO SUBMIT

COPY OF PASSPORT AND ID PHOTO

- A recent, clear, and coloured copy of your passport and ID photo is required.
- Please refer to the [ICA photo guidelines](#) to ensure strict compliance of the ID photo.

TRANSCRIPTS AND CERTIFICATES

- Submit a signed and stamped official transcript in English, reflecting all completed modules.
- A list of modules taken in the current semester should be included if not shown in the transcript.
- Nominees whose home institution's medium of instruction is not English are required to submit results for one of the following English language qualifications: IELTS 6.0 / TOEFL iBT 80 / PTE Academic 50."

PORTFOLIO

- Programme requirements might necessitate distinct portfolio criteria. DQPGE will provide additional information alongside the application email.

HEALTH DECLARATION

- Health declarations must be supported with a doctor's certification letter or memo if special assistance is needed while at LASALLE.



ENTRY INTO SINGAPORE

ENTRY VISA

As an exchange student, you need not apply for an entry visa separately to enter Singapore. Instead, upon approval of the Student's Pass (STP) application, an In-Principle Approval (IPA) letter will be issued by LASALLE's Admissions team. This letter will include a single journey visa to facilitate entry into Singapore.

STUDENT PASS (STP)

You must possess a valid Student's Pass (STP) issued by the Singapore Immigration & Checkpoints Authority (ICA) for the duration of your programme.

It is a mandatory requirement for all STP applicants to be **fully vaccinated** with the approved COVID-19 vaccines. You will receive guidance for the STP application process after accepting our offer, so we **recommend arranging your travel plans only after the STP application is approved.**

Please keep in mind that as an STP holder, you are **prohibited from engaging in any work activities**, whether paid or unpaid, during the entire exchange period.

HEALTH SCREENING

If your exchange duration at LASALLE exceeds 6 months, you must undergo a health screening after arrival as part of the Student's Pass requirements.

HEALTH/ MEDICAL DECLARATION

To prioritise your well-being, it is important to disclose all existing medical conditions, including but not limited to physical/mobility limitations, sensory impairments, neurological deficits, and learning disabilities, in your application. Additional medical documentation and specialist evaluation may be requested to properly evaluate your application.

GETTING TO CAMPUS

LASALLE (McNally Campus) is located in the central part of the island and is easily accessible by public transport (bus and MRT train).

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

You are expected to attend classes from the first day of the semester and it is recommended to arrive a week before to settle in and attend orientation.

If you are unable to arrive on time, please contact DQPGE. Return flights should be arranged after the semester ends as assessments may fall on the last day. Failure to submit any assignment without valid reasons will result in module failure.

ORIENTATION

You are invited to attend an orientation at the beginning of each semester to learn more about LASALLE, meet other international students, and explore the Arts District. Attendance is highly recommended for all exchange students.

MEDICAL INSURANCE*

You are required to be covered under the Medical Insurance Scheme (MIS) for school-related activities. The coverage of S\$20,000 is valid for the programme's duration, and the current premium rate is SGD\$29.70 per semester, subject to change based on the prevailing premiums charged by the insurer and GST rate.

MISCELLANEOUS FEES

LASALLE will provide basic learning materials for you, but as a developing artist, you'll need to have certain personal items to support you throughout your learning journey. These items are not to be shared and may include a laptop, if applicable.

BANKING SERVICES

CRAZY RICH CITY? ESTIMATED MONTHLY EXPENSES

Contrary to its reputation as one of the world's most expensive cities, Singapore can be a surprisingly affordable and comfortable place to live. Here is a breakdown of the expected monthly expenses in Singapore dollars:

CLIMATE

Singapore's spot on the map is just one degree north of the equator, making it a tropical paradise that stays cozy all year long. The humidity is high, and rain showers are frequent guests to this lush land.



LANGUAGE

AVG TEMPERATURE

All year round 25°C to 32°C (77 to 90°F).

Hottest months - April to May, temperatures often go above 33°C and can reach 35°C (91- 95°F)

Driest month - February



RAINFALL

Highest rainfall experienced from November to January.
