



All foreign exchange students need to obtain D-2-6 visa for their studies at Hanyang. D-2-6 visa is

a single-entry visa and it will be valid only for 90 days after student's arrival in Korea. Therefore,

students should apply for an "Alien Registration Card (ARC)" to extend their stay to complete the

1000+ English Courses

Each year Hanyang offers more than 1000 English courses from 15 Colleges and 62 Departments, such as College of Engineering, School of Business, College of Economics and Finance, Division of International Studies, and College of Humanities.



Course Registration

Course registration begins 1 month before the beginning of the semester. Students would be required to choose 1 department of their preference among approximately 62 departments available at the application stage. Although each student will be registered to a specific department, all students will have opportunities to register for desired courses beyond their department.

Credits and Transcript



Following the US academic system; 1 credit equals 15-16 contact hours, students can take up to 20 credits at Hanyang. The transcript will be mailed to the home University approximately one month after the semester ends.
