After arrival in Korea, students are AUTOMATICALLY subscribed to the National Health Insurance (Monthly fee: approx. KRW72,000). Private insurance is still required throughout the stay as additional safeguard against any unexpected situations such as emergency repatriation.</p>
<b>Visa Requirements</b>	<p>Students MUST obtain <b>D-2-6(Exchange Student Visa)</b> BEFORE they enter Korea.</p>
