ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR EXCHANGE STUDENTS	
Nomination Deadline (compulsory)	First semester (Autumn semester) or full academic year: 15th of June Second semester (Spring semester): 15th of November
Nomination should be done in this website:	https://www.ehu.eus/en/web/ekonomia-enpresa-fakultatea/exchange-nomination-form
Nomination will include the following information	Name and surname; ID/passport number; date of birth; gender, e-mail address; exchange period requested and study field
Online registration (compulsory)	After the nomination, the student will receive an email with a link to do the online application .
Documents the student should upload to the online application before your arrival	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learning agreement • Copy of ID or passport • Required insurance document • European Insurance Card (if possible)
Deadline for online registration by the students (compulsory)	First semester (Autumn semester) or full academic year: 30th of June Second semester (Spring semester): 30th of November

	Classes: End of January – May Exam period: May/June
	The students can have a second exam in an extraordinary period (June/July)
