NOMINATION AND APPLICATION PROCEDURES FOR INCOMING STUDENTS

Nomination Process	The standing procedure to be followed is that the home University first nominates the students filling out an online form previously provided. <u>Fall semester/Entire academic course deadline</u> → May 16 th <u>Spring semester deadline</u> → October 10 th
Application Deadline	<u>Fall semester/Entire academic course</u> → June 13 th <u>Spring semester</u> → November 7 th
Online registration	The student will be requested to access to the online platform and submit the Application form and the following documentation: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Passport copy 2. ID card photo 3. Insurance Form properly filled in and signed 4. Official Transcript of Records 5. Language certification (if required) 6. Course Enrollment Form
VISA requirement & Legal Help	All applicants from Non-EU country need a visa to study in Spain. Therefore, the applicants should have a sufficient command of Spanish or English to be able to follow classes without difficulty.</p> <p>Minimum requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Classes taught in English: TOEFL 75 IBT, IELTS 6 or equivalent (except students from Canada, United Kingdom and United States). - Classes taught in Spanish: B2 Certificate or equivalent (except students from Latin America).
