Min / Max Credits

Every incoming student must at least enroll into modules with a total of 12 ECTS. The maximum amount of ECTS credits are 32 ECTS.

Time Table

Block Weeks / Special Weeks

Please be aware that some modules are taught during Block Weeks/Special Weeks and attendance is **mandatory**. Please check the time table to find out which modules are taking place in these weeks.

Limited Spots

Some modules have limited spots available. These spots will be filled on a first come first serve basis. Therefore, we recommend to return module selections as soon as possible.

Module Changes

Please note, as soon as the Learning Agreement has been finalised, module changes are only possible in the first two semester weeks. Drop outs don't need further explanation. Drop ins into new modules are only accepted in very exceptional cases, eg. time table clashes that appear or requirements are not met in another module.
